

**Ephesians 6:10~** Finally, go on acquiring power in the Lord and in the mightiness of his strength.

- 1· Finally Paul counsels to go on acquiring power through the Holy Spirit, in the Lord, and grow in the mightiness of his spiritual strength.

**[Question]** What does Paul now counsel them, to keep on growing in daily?

- 2· To the end, that he may grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be made mighty in the man you are inside, with power through his spirit. (**Ephesians 3:16**)

**[Question]** What kind of mightiness was Paul here speaking of, and what builds this power, within an anointed Christian?

- 3· Stay awake, stand firm in the faith, carry on as men, grow mighty. (**1 Corinthians 16:13**)

**[Question]** How should anointed Christians stand, once they progress past the elementary things of Christianity?

- 4· And Moses proceeded to call Joshua and say to him before the eyes of all Israel; Be courageous and strong, because you, you will bring this people into the land, that Yehowah swore to their forefathers to give to them, and you yourself will give it to them, as an inheritance. (**Deuteronomy 31:7**)

**[Question]** What counsel did Yehowah give to Joshua, through Moses, about how to walk before him in the future?

- 5· I am going in the way of all the earth, and you must be strong, and prove yourself to be a man. (**1 Kings 2:2**)

**[Question]** What fine counsel did David give to Solomon his son as a king over all Israel?

- 6· Yehowah is my strength and my shield. In him my heart has trusted, and I have been helped, so that my heart exults, and with my song I shall laud him. (**Psalms 28:7**)

**[Question]** Who did the Psalmist feel was his strength, and how did he feel about him?

- 7· One wise in strength is an able-bodied man, and a man of

knowledge is reinforcing **power**. (**Proverbs 24:5**)

**[Question]** What is a man of knowledge doing through his knowledge and wisdom?

- 8· Say to those who are anxious at heart; Be strong. Do not be afraid. Look! Your own God will come with vengeance itself, God even with a repayment. He himself will come and save you people. (**Isaiah 35:4**)

**[Question]** What did Isaiah counsel the people who were anxious at heart, for who was with them?

- 9· But now be strong, O Zerubbabel, is the utterance of Yehowah, and be strong, O Joshua the son of Jehozadak the High Priest. And be strong, all you people of the land, is the utterance of Yehowah, and work. For I am with you people, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies (**Haggai 2:4**)

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God conduct his people the Haggai about the temple rebuilding work?

- 10· You, therefore, my child, keep on **acquiring power** in the undeserved kindness, that is in connection with Christ Jesus. (**2 Timothy 2:1**)

**[Question]** What was Timothy told to go on acquiring power in, and how would he do this?

- 11· But, after you have suffered a little while, the God of all undeserved kindness, who called you to his everlasting glory in union with Christ, will himself finish your training, he will make you firm, he will make you strong. (**1 Peter 5:10**)

**[Question]** What will Yehowah God do for those who willingly submit to suffering in behalf of Christ?

**[Question]** How does such discipline through suffering, then make us stronger spiritually?

- 12· I write you, fathers, because you have come to know him who is from the beginning. I write you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God remains in you, and you have conquered the wicked one. (**1 John 2:14**)

**[Question]** Why were the young men that John wrote to, strong?
