

Ephesians 6:13~ On this account take up the complete suit¹ of armor from God, that you may be able to resist in the wicked day and, after you have done all things thoroughly, to stand firm.

Footnote: Literally, the panoply Greek, *ten pa·no·pli'an*; Latin, *ar·ma·tu'ram*

1· Therefore, since our enemy is well organized and intent on hurting us, we had better suit up for the battle with a complete suit of armor, for it will be a long war. If we do have a complete suit of armor, then we will be able to resist in the wicked day and complete our Christian course, that of putting to death the desires of the flesh through our love of the Holy Spirit from God. Thus we can stand our ground, and even advance against this powerful enemy, Satan the Devil, and then to stand victorious over him.

[Question] What suit then, do we need to take into this fight, and how will it protect us?

[Question] Why must this suit be complete?

[Question] What will we be able to make progress against, if our suit of armor is complete?

2· By truthful speech, by God's power. Through the weapons of righteousness on the right hand, and on the left. (**2 Corinthians 6:7**)

[Question] What kind of speech should we always use, and whose power must we depend upon?

[Question] What kind of weapons do we fight with solely?

3· Rooted and being built up in him, and being stabilized in the faith, just as you were taught, overflowing with faith in thanksgiving. (**Colossians 2:7**)

[Question] What should we do after starting out, through baptism?

4· For the weapons of our warfare are not fleshly, but powerful by God, for overturning strongly entrenched things. (**2 Corinthians 10:4**)

[Question] Are the weapons of an anointed Christian ever fleshly weapons?

[Question] What though are they, and what things are they capable of overturning?
