

Ephesians 6:15~ And with your feet shod with the equipment¹ of the Good News of peace.

Footnote: With the equipment Literally, in readiness; in preparedness

1· Our feet also could be cut, if they were uncovered, causing us to be unable to flee from an opponent. They must be covered with the equipment of the Good News of peace. We must preach to remain strong, and refresh our minds about the things we have been taught. As we go in service to God in the preaching work, we are also protecting ourselves, and we get spiritually stronger the more we do these things.

[Question] What would an injury to the foot cause us to be unable to do?

[Question] What then, will protect our feet in this warfare?

[Question] How does the preaching work, and Bible study with others, strengthen us?

[Question] What then, are we doing every time we go out in the preaching work?

2· How comely upon the mountains are the feet of the one bringing Good News, the one publishing peace, the one bringing Good News of something better, the one publishing salvation, the one saying to Zion; Your God has become king! (Isaiah 52:7)

[Question] What does Isaiah say about the one bringing Good News, that the Kingdom has come?

3· He sent out the word to the sons of Israel to declare to them the Good News of peace through Jesus Christ. This One is Lord of all others. (Acts of Apostles 10:36)

[Question] What word does Yehowah God send out among mankind, through the preaching of the Good News of God's Kingdom?

4· How, in turn, will they preach unless they have been sent forth? Just as it is written: How comely are the feet of those who declare Good News of good things! (Romans 10:15)

[Question] What commission do they need to have to preach, and where does it come from?

[Question] How will people come to feel, about those doing this fine works toward others?

- 5· **And in this way you should eat it, with your hips girded, sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand, and you must eat it in haste. It is Yehowah's Passover. (Exodus 12:11)**

[Question] How were the men of the army of Israel to prepare for their departure from Egypt?

- 6· **For me to be a public servant of Christ Jesus to the nations, engaging in the holy work of the Good News of God, in order, that the offering, namely, these nations, might prove to be acceptable, it being sanctified with Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:16)**

[Question] What holy work was Paul engaged in, and what sanctifies these nations?
