

Ephesians 6:19~ Also for me, that ability to speak may be given me with the opening of my mouth, with freeness of speech to make known the sacred secret of the Good News.

- 1• Paul then also asks them to pray for him, that the ability to speak freely may be given him, at the opening of his mouth. Also, that he might not speak out of fearfulness, but with boldness, to make the sacred secret of the Good News of God's Kingdom known.

[Question] What ability did Paul ask for them to pray for him, and in his behalf?

[Question] How did Paul need, and want, to present the Good News of God to the nations?

- 2• And now, Yehowah, give attention to their threats, and grant your slaves to keep speaking your word with all boldness. (**Acts of Apostles 4:29**)

[Question] What did the disciples of Christ ask of God, when the Jews took to persecuting them?

- 3• Therefore, as we have such a hope, we are using great **freeness of speech**. (**2 Corinthians 3:12**)

[Question] What are we using when preaching the Good News of God, and what gives us boldness?

- 4• For the men who minister in a fine manner are acquiring for themselves a fine standing, and great **freeness of speech**, in the faith, in connection with Christ Jesus. (**1 Timothy 3:13**)

[Question] What are those men who minister acquiring for themselves in the faith?

- 5• But Christ was faithful as a Son over the house of that One. We are the house of that One, if we **make** fast our hold on our **freeness of speech**, and our boasting over the hope, firm to the end. (**Hebrews 3:6**)

[Question] What house do anointed Christians comprise?

[Question] What will assure them of reaching their goals?

- 6• Provided, of course, that you continue in the faith,

established on the foundation and steadfast, and not being shifted away from the hope of that Good News, which you heard, and which was preached, in all creation that is under heaven. Of this Good News, I Paul, became a minister. (**Colossians 1:23**)

[Question] What must anointed Christians remain firmly seated upon always?

- 7· At the same time praying also for us, that God may open a door of utterance to us, to **speak** the **sacred secret** about the Christ, for which, in fact, I am in prison bonds. (**Colossians 4:3**)

[Question] What did Paul ask them to pray for him to be able to do, though he was in prison bonds?

- 8· Preaching the kingdom of God to them, and teaching the things concerning the Lord Jesus Christ, with the greatest **freeness** of **speech**, without hindrance. (**Acts of Apostles 28:31**)

[Question] What should anointed Christians teach, and what word should they always speak out boldly?

- 9· In the face of this, when you read this, you can realize the comprehension I have, in the **sacred secret** of the Christ. (**Ephesians 3:4**)

[Question] What kind of comprehension did Paul have in the Good News of God?
