

**Ephesians 6:21~** Now, in order, that you may also know about my affairs, as to how I am doing, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, will make everything known to you.

- 1• Paul was now sending Tychicus, who was a brother beloved to Paul, and also a faithful minister to the Lord, to them in Ephesus, to make known everything about Paul to them.

**[Question]** Who then, was Paul going to send to them, there in Ephesus to assist them?

- 2• But I have sent **Tychicus** off to Ephesus. (**2 Timothy 4:12**)

**[Question]** What did Paul later attest to in his letter to Timothy?

- 3• When I send Artemas or **Tychicus** to you, do your utmost to come to me at Nicopolis, for there is where I have decided to winter. (**Titus 3:12**)

**[Question]** What other men were around Paul, and useful to him for ministering?

- 4• All my **affairs Tychicus**, my **beloved brother** and **faithful minister** and fellow slave in the **Lord**, **will make known** to you. (**Colossians 4:7**)

**[Question]** Who else was used by Paul to minister to others within the congregations?

- 5• There were accompanying him Sopater the son of Pyrrhus of Beroea, Aristarchus and Secundus of the Thessalonians, and Gaius of Derbe, and Timothy, and from the district of Asia **Tychicus** and Trophimus. (**Acts of Apostles 20:4**)

**[Question]** Who were some of the faithful men who surrounded Paul and assisted him?

- 6• Greet Herodion my relative. Greet those from the household of Narcissus who are in the **Lord**. (**Romans 16:11**)

**[Question]** Who did Paul then send his greetings to in Rome?

- 7• That is why, if I come, I **will** call to remembrance his works which he goes on **doing**, chattering **about** us with wicked words. Also, not being content with these things, neither

**does he himself receive the **brothers** with respect, and those who are wanting to receive them he tries to hinder and to throw out of the congregation. (3 John 1:10)**

**[Question]** How did one Diotrephes treat the Apostle John in his later years?
