Ephesians 6:3~ That it may go well with you and you may endure a long time on the earth.

1. Now Paul shows what that promise is, that it may go well with them and they may live a long time upon the earth. So then the promise is to a long and fruitful life, for children honoring their parents through obedience.

**[Question]** What is the promise for obedience to parents?

2. Honor your father and your mother, just as Yehowah your God has commanded you, in order, that your days may prove long and it may go well with you on the ground that Yehowah your God is giving you. (Deuteronomy 5:16)

[Question] What did Moses tell the Israelites about honoring their parents?

And no house must you build, and no seed must you sow, and no vineyard must you plant, nor must it come to be yours. But in tents you should dwell all your days, in order, that you may keep living many days upon the surface of the ground where you are residing as aliens. (Jeremiah 35:7)

[Question] What did the sons of Jehonadab do to honor their father, long after his death, per his command?
