Ephesians 6:6~ Not by way of eye-service as men pleasers, but as Christ's slaves, doing the will of God whole-souled.

1. Slaves who are also Christians, should not serve their masters with mere acts of eyeservice, just trying to be pleasers of men, but they should be Christ's slaves first, thus doing the will of God whole-souled, knowing, that their God in heaven sees all their works, and much more about them than they even realize.

**[Question]** How should anointed Christians slaves avoid serving their masters?

[Question] What are they first and foremost, and who also sees all of their works, and will be the one to reward them, for their faithful service, in time?

2. And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a complete heart and with a delightful soul, for all hearts Yehowah is searching, and every inclination of the thoughts he is discerning. If you search for him, he will let himself be found by you, but if you leave him, he will cast you off forever. (1 Chronicles 28:9)

[Question] What does Yehowah God know about each person intimately, even before the person himself knows it?

[Question] If a man searches for Yehowah God, will he be able to find him?

3. You slaves, be obedient in everything to those who are your masters in a fleshly sense, not with acts of eyeservice, as men pleasers, but with sincerity of heart, with fear of Yehowah. (Colossians 3:22)

[Question] How should anointed Christian slaves treat their masters instructions, and with sincerity of heart to whom?

4. In answer he said: You must love Yehowah your God with your whole heart, and with your whole soul, and with your whole strength, and with your whole mind, and, your neighbor as yourself. (Luke 10:27)

[Question] Who must mankind love with their whole heart and soul, and mind and strength?

5. Let all, that is by the order of the God of the heavens, be

done with zeal, for the house of the God of the heavens, that there may occur no wrath against the king's realm and his sons. (Ezra 7:23)

[Question] What did the king order regarding Yehowah's house, and why?

6. And she went on uncovering her acts of prostitution and uncovering her nakedness, so that my soul turned away disgusted from company with her, just as my soul had turned away disgusted from company with her sister. (Ezekiel 23:18)

[Question] How does Yehowah God feel, when people turn from righteousness, and practice wickedness, either openly or in secret?

7. Nevertheless, I do hold this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and misleads my slaves to commit fornication and to eat things sacrificed to idols. (Revelation 2:20)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ counsel the anointed congregations about a Jezebel like influence, within their midst?
