Ephesians 6:7~ Be slaves with good inclinations, as to Yehowah, and not to men.

1. Since they are Christians, and also slaves of other men, they should show good inclinations to Yehowah, and this will always mean serving their masters with their very best effort, even as we give our best to Yehowah God in all things.
