

**Ephesians 6:8~** For you know that each one, whatever good he may do, will receive this back from Yehowah,<sup>1</sup> whether he be slave or freeman.

- 1• **Christian slaves should understand the principle, that whatever we do, this is what we will reap. For Yehowah God is not partial to any man, but judges every man according to their works. This applies to slaves as well as to freemen.**

**[Question]** What is Yehowah God not in judgment?

- 2• **He *will* carry away blessing from *Yehowah*, and righteousness from his God of salvation. (*Psalms 24:5*)**

**[Question]** What will the one innocent in his heart and clean in his hands, carry away from Yehowah God?

- 3• **For you *know*, that it is from *Yehowah* you *will receive* the due reward of the inheritance. Slave for the Master, Christ. (*Colossians 3:24*)**

**[Question]** Who will anointed Christians slaves receive the due reward of their inheritance from, and so who must they become acceptable to?

- 4• **There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither *slave* nor *freeman*, there is neither male nor female. You are all one person in union with Christ Jesus. (*Galatians 3:28*)**

**[Question]** What prior distinctions disappear through Christianity?

- 5• **Then Yehowah's angel said to her; I shall greatly multiply your seed, so that it *will* not be numbered for multitude. (*Genesis 16:10*)**

**[Question]** What promise was made to Hagar, if she would return to her master, Sarah, and become obedient to her direction?

- 6• **So he said to him; You yourself must *know*, how I have served you, and how your herd has fared with me. (*Genesis 30:29*)**

**[Question]** What did Jacob say, about the way that he had faithfully served Laban, for his daughters?

- 7· And you yourselves certainly **know, that with all my power,** I have served your father. (**Genesis 31:6**)

**[Question]** How did Jacob serve Laban?

- 8· For anyone in the Lord that was called when a **slave** is the Lord's freedman. Likewise he that was called when a **freeman,** is a **slave** of Christ. (**1 Corinthians 7:22**)

**[Question]** What are all anointed ones to become, whether free or slave to start with?
