

## KEEP LIVING - WALKS IN STATUTES OF GOD

~ **Men ... Righteous ... Keep Living** - He walks in my statutes and my judicial decisions in order to execute truth, he is righteous, he will positively keep living says Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 18:9**) <sup>[14]</sup> - References

**Ezekiel 18:9** In my statutes he kept walking and my judicial decisions he kept in order to execute truth, he is righteous. He will positively keep living, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah.

- Watch out for yourself that you may not forget Yehowah your God so as not to **keep** his commandments and his **judicial decisions** and his statutes that I am commanding you today. (**Deuteronomy 8:11**)
- And now, O Israel, listen to the regulations and the **judicial decisions** that I am teaching **you** to do, in order, that **you** may live and may indeed go in and take possession of the land that Yehowah the God of **your** forefathers is giving **you**. (**Deuteronomy 4:1**)
- And Moses proceeded to call all Israel and to say to them; Hear, O Israel, the regulations and the **judicial decisions** that I am speaking in **your** ears today, and **you** must learn them and be careful to do them. (**Deuteronomy 5:1**)
- And I proceeded to give them my statutes, and my **judicial decisions** I made known to them, in order, that the man who **keeps** doing them might also **keep** living by them. (**Ezekiel 20:11**)
- He **will** carry away blessing from Yehowah and righteousness from his God of salvation. (**Psalms 24:5**)
- And **you** must **keep** my statutes and my **judicial decisions**, which if a man **will** do, he must also live by means of them. I am Yehowah. (**Leviticus 18:5**)
- Although you would bear witness against them to bring them back to your Law, they themselves even acted presumptuously and did not listen to your commandments, and against your own **judicial decisions** they sinned, which, if a man **will** do, he must also live by means of them. And they **kept** giving a stubborn shoulder, and their neck they hardened, and they did not listen. (**Nehemiah 9:29**)

- For this is what Yehowah has said to the house of Israel, Search for me, and **keep** living. (**Amos 5:4**)
- For Moses writes that the man that has done the righteousness of the Law **will** live by it. (**Romans 10:5**)
- Now the Law does not adhere to faith, but he that does them shall live by means of them. (**Galatians 3:12**)
- From the afflicted one he has drawn back his hand, no usury and interest has he taken, my **judicial decisions** he has carried out, in my statutes he has walked, he himself **will** not die because of the error of his father. He **will positively keep** living. (**Ezekiel 18:17**)
- And **you** people **will** certainly say; Why is it that the son does not have to bear anything because of the error of the father? Now as regards the son, justice and righteousness he has executed, all the statutes of mine he has **kept** and he **keeps** doing them. He **will positively keep** living. (**Ezekiel 18:19**)
- For I do not take any delight in the death of someone dying, is the **utterance** of the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah. So cause a turning back and **keep** living, O **you** people. (**Ezekiel 18:32**)
- But they, the house of Israel, rebelled against me in the wilderness. In my statutes they did not walk, and my **judicial decisions** they rejected, which, should the man **keep** doing, he **will** also **keep** living by them. And my Sabbaths they profaned very much, so that I promised to pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, in **order** to exterminate them. (**Ezekiel 20:13**)
