Leviticus 18:5... **And you must keep my statutes and my judicial decisions, which if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. I am Yehowah.**

- And I proceeded to give them my **statutes**, and my **judicial decisions** I made known to them, in order, that the **man** who **keeps** doing them might also **keep** living by them. (**Ezekiel 20:11**)
- He said to him; You answered correctly, keep on doing this and you **will** get life. (**Luke 10:28**)
- For Moses writes that the **man** that has done the righteousness of the Law **will live** by it. (**Romans 10:5**)
- Now the Law does not adhere to faith, but he that does them shall **live** by **means** of them. (**Galatians 3:12**)
- And God went on to speak to Moses and to say to him; **I am Yehowah**. (**Exodus 6:2**)
- For **I am Yehowah**, I have not changed. And **you** are sons of Jacob, **you** have not come to **your** finish. (**Malachi 3:6**)
- So **you must keep** all my **statutes** and all my **judicial decisions**, and **you must** do them. **I am Yehowah**. (**Leviticus 19:37**)
- And now, O Israel, listen to the regulations and the **judicial decisions** that **I am** teaching **you** to do, in order, that **you** may **live** and may indeed go in and take possession of the land that **Yehowah** the God of **your** forefathers is giving **you**. (**Deuteronomy 4:1**)
- These are the testimonies and the regulations and the **judicial decisions** that Moses spoke to the sons of Israel on their coming out of Egypt. (**Deuteronomy 4:45**)

- And it **will** mean righteousness for us, that we take care to do all this commandment before **Yehowah** our God, just as he has commanded us. (**Deuteronomy 6:25**)
- If you **will** listen to the commandments of **Yehowah** your God, which I **am** commanding you today, so as to love **Yehowah** your God, to walk in his ways and to **keep** his commandments and his **statutes** and his **judicial decisions**, then you **will** be bound to **keep** alive and to multiply, and **Yehowah** your God **must** bless you in the land to which you are going to take possession of it. (**Deuteronomy 30:16**)
- For it is no valueless word for **YOU**, but it **means YOUR** life, and by this word **YOU** may lengthen **YOUR** days upon the soil to which **YOU** are crossing the Jordan to take possession of it. (**Deuteronomy 32:47**)
- Although you would bear witness against them to bring them back to your Law, they themselves even acted presumptuously and did not listen to your commandments, and against your own **judicial decisions** they sinned, which, if a **man will** do, he **must** also **live** by **means** of them. And they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their neck they hardened, and they did not listen. (**Nehemiah 9:29**)
- Act appropriately toward your servant, that I may **live** and that I may **keep** your word. (**Psalms 119:17**)
- The way of faithfulness I have chosen. Your **judicial decisions** I have considered appropriate. (**Psalms 119:30**)
- To time indefinite I shall not forget your orders, because by them you have preserved me alive. (**Psalms 119:93**)
- I have made a sworn statement, and I **will** carry it out, to **keep** your righteous **judicial decisions**. (**Psalms 119:106**)
- And he would instruct me and say to me; May your heart **keep** fast hold of my words. Keep my commandments and continue living. (**Proverbs 4:4**)
- Keep my commandments and continue living, and my Law like the pupil of your eyes. (**Proverbs 7:2**)
- In my **statutes** he kept walking and my **judicial decisions** he kept in order to execute truth, he is righteous. He **will** positively **keep** living, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 18:9**)
- Search for what is good, and not what is bad, to the end that **you** people may **keep** living, and that thus **Yehowah** the God of armies may come to be with **you**, just as **you** have said. (**Amos 5:14**)

- He said to him; Why do you ask me about what is good? One there is that is good. If, though, you want to enter into life, observe the commandments continually. (**Matthew 19:17**)
- They both were righteous before God because of walking blamelessly in accord with all the commandments and legal requirements of **Yehowah**. (**Luke 1:6**)
- He said to him; What is written in the Law? How do you read? (**Luke 10:26**)
- And the commandment which was to life, this I found to be to death. (**Romans 7:10**)
- However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (**James 1:22**)
