- For I, **Yehowah** your God, **am** grasping your right hand, the One saying to you, Do not be afraid. I myself **will** help you. (**Isaiah 41:13**)
- Do not be afraid, for I **am** with you. From the sunrising I shall bring your seed, and from the sunset I shall collect you together. (**Isaiah 43:5**)
- This is what **Yehowah** has said, your Maker and your Former, who kept helping you even from the belly; Do not be afraid, O my **servant Jacob**, and you, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen. (**Isaiah 44:2**)
- But this is what **Yehowah** has said; Even the body of captives of the mighty man **will** be taken away, and those already taken by the tyrant himself **will** make their escape. And against anyone contending against you I myself shall contend, and your own sons I myself shall save. (**Isaiah 49:25**)
- In those days they **will** walk, the house of Judah alongside the house of **Israel**, and together they **will** come out of the **land** of the north into the **land** that I gave as a hereditary possession to **YOUR** forefathers. (**Jeremiah 3:18**)
- In those days Judah **will** be saved and Jerusalem itself **will** reside in security. And this is what she **will** be called, **Yehowah** Is Our Righteousness. (**Jeremiah 33:16**)

· And as for you, do not be afraid, O my **servant Jacob**, and do not be terror-stricken, O **Israel**. For here I **am saving** you from **far away** and your **offspring** from the **land** of their **captivity**. And **Jacob will certainly return** and have no **disturbance** and be at **ease** and without anyone **causing** trembling. (**Jeremiah 46:27**)

· And I **will** conclude with them a covenant of peace, and I shall **certainly** cause the injurious wild beast to cease out of the **land**, and they **will** actually dwell in the wilderness in security and sleep in the forests. (**Ezekiel 34:25**)

· And for them I shall **certainly** conclude a covenant in that day in connection with the wild beast of the field and with the flying creature of the heavens and the creeping thing of the ground, and the bow and the sword and war I shall break out of the **land**, and I **will** make them lie down in security. (**Hosea 2:18**)

· And they **will** actually sit, each one under his vine and under his fig tree, and there **will** be no one making them tremble, for the very mouth of **Yehowah** of armies has spoken it. (**Micah 4:4**)

· And I **will** put peace in the **land**, and **you will** indeed lie down, with no one making **you** tremble, and I **will** make the injurious wild beast cease out of the **land**, and a sword **will** not pass through **YOUR land**. (**Leviticus 26:6**)

· And it must occur in the day when **Yehowah** gives you rest from your pain and from your agitation and from the hard slavery in which you were made a slave. (**Isaiah 14:3**)

· And now listen, O **Jacob** my **servant**, and you, O **Israel**, whom I have chosen. (**Isaiah 44:1**)

· As for you, do not be afraid, O my **servant** Jacob, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, for I **am** with you. For I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I have dispersed you, but with you I shall make no extermination. Yet I shall have to chastise you to the proper degree, and I shall absolutely not leave you unpunished. (**Jeremiah 46:28**)

· And when it occurs I **will** let **you** have as a remnant the ones escaping from the sword among the nations, when **you** get scattered among the **lands**. (**Ezekiel 6:8**)

· Therefore say; This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; I **will** also collect **you** from the peoples and gather **you** from the

lands among which **you** have been scattered, and I **will** give **you** the soil of **Israel**. (**Ezekiel 11:17**)

- And they **will** no longer become something to plunder for the nations, and as regards the wild beast of the earth, it **will** not devour them, and they **will** actually dwell in security, with no one to make them tremble. (**Ezekiel 34:28**)
- When I bring them back from the peoples and I actually collect them together out of the **lands** of their enemies, I **will** also sanctify myself among them before the eyes of many nations. (**Ezekiel 39:27**)
- And I **will** gather back the captive ones of my people **Israel**, and they **will** actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (**Amos 9:14**)
- And it must become a region for the remaining ones of the house of Judah. Upon them they **will** feed. In the houses of Ashkelon, in the evening, they **will** lie stretched out. For **Yehowah** their God **will** turn his attention to them and **certainly** gather back the captive ones of them. (**Zephaniah 2:7**)
- As regards the remaining ones of **Israel**, they **will** do no unrighteousness, nor speak a lie, nor **will** there be found in their mouths a tricky tongue, for they themselves **will** feed and actually lie stretched out, and there **will** be no one making them tremble. (**Zephaniah 3:13**)
- At that time I shall bring **you** people in, even in the time of my collecting **you** together. For I shall make **you** people to be a name and a praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I gather back **your** captive ones before **your** eyes, **Yehowah** has said. (**Zephaniah 3:20**)
- And **Yehowah** proceeded to answer the angel who was speaking with me, with good words, comforting words. (**Zechariah 1:13**)
- This is what **Yehowah** of armies has said; There **will** yet sit old men and old women in the public squares of Jerusalem, each one also with his staff in his hand because of the abundance of his days. (**Zechariah 8:4**)
