- Why do you keep your very face **concealed**? Why do you forget our affliction and our oppression? (**Psalms 44:24**)
- I, I am Yehowah, and besides me there is no savior. (**Isaiah 43:11**)
- And you will actually suck the milk of nations, and the breast of kings you will suck, and you will be certain to know that I, Yehowah, am your **Savior**, and the Powerful One of Jacob is your Repurchaser. (**Isaiah 60:16**)
- Whereas in his own due times he made his word manifest in the preaching with which I was entrusted, under command of our **Savior, God**. (**Titus 1:3**)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to me; I will keep undisturbed and look upon my established place, like the dazzling heat along with the light, like the cloud of dew in the heat of harvest. (**Isaiah 18:4**)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said to the house of Jacob, he that redeemed Abraham; Jacob will not now be ashamed, nor will his own face now grow pale. (**Isaiah 29:22**)
- And Yehowah will certainly give **you** people bread in the form of distress and water in the form of oppression, yet your Grand Instructor will no longer hide himself, and your eyes must become eyes seeing your Grand Instructor. (**Isaiah 30:20**)
- And you kept trusting in your badness. You have said; There is no one seeing me. Your wisdom and your knowledge, this is what has led you away, and you keep saying in your heart; I am, and there is nobody else. (**Isaiah 47:10**)

- With a flood of indignation I **concealed** my face from you for but a moment, but with loving-kindness to time indefinite I will have mercy upon you, your Repurchaser, Yehowah, has said. (**Isaiah 54:8**)
