- **You** yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, that I might carry **YOU** on wings of eagles and bring **YOU** to myself. (**Exodus 19:4**)
- To the contrary, continue to love **YOUR** enemies and to do good and to lend without interest, not hoping for anything back, and **YOUR** reward **will** be great, and **you will** be sons of the Most High, because he is kind **toward** the unthankful and wicked. (**Luke 6:35**)
- Or do you despise the riches of his **kindness** and forbearance and long-suffering, because you do not know that the kindly quality of God is trying to lead you to repentance? (**Romans 2:4**)
- I desire to remind **YOU**, despite **YOUR** knowing all things once for all time, that Yehowah, although he saved a people out of the land of Egypt, afterwards destroyed those not showing faith. (**Jude 1:5**)
- Look! **YOUR** house is abandoned to **YOU**. (**Matthew 23:38**)
- Through which **YOU** are also being saved, with the speech with which I declared the Good News to **YOU**, if **YOU** are holding it fast, unless, in fact, **YOU** became believers to no purpose. (**1 Corinthians 15:2**)
- And throw the good-for-nothing slave out into the darkness outside. There is where his weeping and the gnashing of his teeth **will** be. (**Matthew 25:30**)

- And these **will** depart into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life. (**Matthew 25:46**)
- On a good day prove yourself to be in goodness, and on a calamitous day see that the true God has made even this exactly as that, to the intent that mankind may not discover anything at all after them. (**Ecclesiastes 7:14**)
