- Then Yehowah said to Samuel; Listen to the voice of the people as respects all that they say to you, for it is not you whom they have rejected, but it is I whom they have rejected from being **king** over them. (**1 Samuel 8:7**)
- And now here is the **king** whom **YOU** have chosen, for whom **YOU** asked, and here Yehowah has put over **YOU** a **king**. (**1 Samuel 12:13**)
- But if **YOU** flagrantly do what is bad, **YOU** will be swept **away**, both **YOU** and **YOUR** king. (**1 Samuel 12:25**)
- And the eyes of Zedekiah he blinded, after which the **king** of Babylon bound him with copper fetters and brought him to Babylon and put him in the house of custody until the day of his death. (**Jeremiah 52:11**)
- And Yehowah proceeded to say to Samuel; Listen to their voice, and you must cause a **king** to reign for them. Accordingly Samuel said to the men of Israel; Go each one to his city. (**1 Samuel 8:22**)
- Is it not wheat harvest today? I shall call to Yehowah that he may **give** thunders and rain, then know and see that **YOUR** evil is abundant that **YOU** have done in the eyes of Yehowah in asking for yourselves a king. (**1 Samuel 12:17**)
- When his armor-bearer saw that Saul had died, then he too fell upon his own sword and died with him. (**1 Samuel 31:5**)
- Thus Saul and three sons of his died, and all those of his house died together. (**1 Chronicles 10:6**)

- Because of the transgression of a land many are its successive princes, but by a discerning man having knowledge of right the prince will remain long. (**Proverbs 28:2**)
- For now they will say; We have no **king**, for we have not feared Yehowah. And as regards the **king**, what will he do for us? (**Hosea 10:3**)
- And after removing him, he raised up for them David as **king**, respecting whom he bore witness and said; I have found David the son of Jesse, a man agreeable to my heart, who will do all the things I desire. (**Acts of Apostles 13:22**)
