- Keep on, then, seeking first the kingdom and his **righteousness**, and all these other things will be added to **you**. (**Matthew 6:33**)
- But on being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of **God** was coming, he answered them and said; The kingdom of **God** is not coming with striking observableness. (**Luke 17:20**)
- But food will not commend us to **God**, if we do not eat, we do not fall short, and, if we eat, we have no credit to ourselves. (**1 Corinthians 8:8**)
- But there are new heavens and a new earth that we are awaiting according to his promise, and in these **righteousness** is to dwell. (**2 Peter 3:13**)
- I leave **you peace**, I give **you my peace**. I do not give it to **you** the way that the world gives it. Do not let **your** hearts be troubled nor let them shrink for fear. (**John 14:27**)
- His master said to him, Well done, good and faithful slave! You were faithful over a few things. I will appoint you over many things. Enter into the **joy** of your master. (**Matthew 25:21**)
- And let justice roll forth just like waters, and **righteousness** like a constantly flowing torrent. (**Amos 5:24**)
- Then he said to his disciples; On this account I say to **you**, quit being anxious about **your** souls as to what **you** will eat or about **your** bodies as to what **you** will wear. (**Luke 12:22**)
- Foods for the belly, and the belly for foods, but **God** will bring both it and them to nothing. Now the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord, and the Lord is for the body. (**1 Corinthians 6:13**)

- Therefore let no man judge **you** in **eating** and **drinking** or in respect of a festival or of an observance of the new moon or of a Sabbath. (**Colossians 2:16**)
- Forbidding to marry, commanding to abstain from foods which **God** created to be partaken of with thanksgiving by those who have faith and accurately know the truth. (**1 Timothy 4:3**)
- Do not be carried away with various and strange teachings, for it is fine for the heart to be given firmness by undeserved kindness, not by eatables, by which those who occupy themselves with them have not been benefited. (**Hebrews 13:9**)
