John 16:3· But they will do these things because they have not come to know either the Father or me.

- Therefore they went on to say to him; Where is your Father? Jesus answered; **You know** neither me nor my **Father**. If **you** did **know** me, **you** would **know** my **Father** also. (John 8:19)
- But they will do all these **things** against **you** on account of my name, because they do not **know** him that sent me. (John 15:21)
- For I bear them witness that they **have** a zeal for God, but not according to accurate knowledge. (Romans 10:2)
- This wisdom not one of the rulers of this system of **things** came to **know**, for if they had known it they would not **have** impaled the glorious Lord. (1 Corinthians 2:8)
- But Pharaoh said; Who is Yehowah, so that I should obey his voice to send Israel away? I do not **know** Yehowah at all and, what is more, I am not going to send Israel away. (Exodus 5:2)
- For there are strangers that **have** risen up against me, and tyrants that do seek my soul. They **have** not set God in front of them. (Psalms 54:3)
- Also, that the soul should be without knowledge is not good, and he that is hastening with his feet is sinning. (Proverbs 19:2)
- And now, brothers, I **know** that **you** acted in ignorance, just as **YOUR** rulers also did. (Acts of Apostles 3:17)
- For the inhabitants of Jerusalem and their rulers did not **know** this One, but, when acting as judges, they fulfilled the **things** voiced by the Prophets, which **things** are read aloud every Sabbath. (Acts of Apostles 13:27)

- See what sort of love the **Father** has given us, so that we should be called children of God, and such we are. That is why the world does not **have** a knowledge of us, because it has not **come** to **know** him. (**1 John 3:1**)
