- Of how much more severe a punishment, do **you** think, will the man be counted worthy who has trampled upon the Son of God and who has esteemed as of ordinary value the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and who has outraged the spirit of undeserved kindness with contempt? (**Hebrews 10:29**)
- And you, Capernaum, will you perhaps be exalted to heaven? Down to Hades you will come, because if the powerful works that took place in you had taken place in Sodom, it would **have** remained until this very day. (**Matthew 11:23**)
- But unconcerned they went off, one to his own field, another to his commercial business. (**Matthew 22:5**)
- And he has raised up a horn of **salvation** for us in the house of David his servant. (**Luke 1:69**)
- Now after John was put under arrest Jesus went into Galilee, preaching the Good News of God (**Mark 1:14**)
- Jesus answered him; I **have spoken** to the world publicly. I always taught in a synagogue and in the temple, where all the Jews come together, and I spoke nothing in secret. (**John 18:20**)
- Just as those who from the beginning became eyewitnesses and attendants of the message delivered these to us. (**Luke 1:2**)
- And it came about that, as soon as they had brought them forth to the outskirts, he **began** to say; Escape for your soul! Do not look

behind you and do not stand still in all the District! Escape to the mountainous region for fear you may be swept away! (**Genesis 19:17**)

- While he was yet speaking, look! A bright cloud overshadowed them, and, look! A voice out of the cloud, saying; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I **have** approved, listen to him. (**Matthew 17:5**)

- Consequently many gathered, so much so that there was no more room, not even about the door, and he **began** to speak the word to them. (**Mark 2:2**)

- Whenever it is that they are saying; Peace and security! Then sudden destruction is to be instantly upon them just as the pang of distress upon a pregnant woman, and they will by no means escape. (**1 Thessalonians 5:3**)

- For yet a very little while, and he who is coming will arrive and will not delay. (**Hebrews 10:37**)

- As God foresaw something better for us, in order, that they might not be made perfect apart from us. (**Hebrews 11:40**)

- See that **you** do not beg off from him who is speaking. For if they did not escape who begged off from him who was giving divine warning upon earth, much more shall we not if we turn away from him who speaks from the heavens. (**Hebrews 12:25**)

- Hence put away all filthiness and that superfluous thing, badness, and accept with mildness the implanting of the word which is able to save **YOUR** souls. (**James 1:21**)

- Yehowah is not slow respecting his promise, as some people consider slowness, but he is patient with **you** because he does not desire any to be destroyed but desires all to attain to repentance. (**2 Peter 3:9**)

- Beloved ones, though I was making every effort to write **you** about the **salvation** we hold in common, I found it necessary to write **you** to exhort **you** to put up a hard fight for the faith that was once for all time delivered to the holy ones. (**Jude 1:3**)
