~ **Paul ... Teaching ... Sects** - As for a man that promotes a sect, reject him after two admonitions· (Titus 3:10) ^[11] - References

Titus 3:10· As for a man that promotes a sect, reject him after a first and a second admonition;

^[11] - References

- For there must also be **sects** among **you**, that the persons approved may also become manifest among **you**. (1 Corinthians 11:19)
- Still, you do have this, that you hate the deeds of the **sect** of Nicolaus, which I also hate. (Revelation 2:6)
- Now I exhort **you**, brothers, to keep your eye on those who cause divisions and occasions for stumbling contrary to the teaching that **you** have learned, and avoid them. (Romans 16:17)
- Now we are giving **you** orders, brothers, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, to withdraw from every brother walking disorderly and not according to the tradition **you** received from us. (2 Thessalonians 3:6)
- But if anyone is not obedient to our word through this letter, keep this one marked, stop associating with him, that he may become ashamed. (2 Thessalonians 3:14)
- If anyone comes to **you** and does not bring this teaching, never receive him into **YOUR** homes or say a greeting to him. (2 John 1:10)
- I have said previously and, as if present the **second** time and yet absent now, I say in advance to those who have sinned before and to all the rest, that if ever I come again I will not spare. (2 Corinthians 13:2)
- Preach the word, be at it urgently in favorable season, in troublesome season, reprove, reprimand, exhort, with all long-suffering and art of teaching. (2 Timothy 4:2)
- But when some went on hardening themselves and not believing, speaking injuriously about The Way before the multitude, he withdrew

from them and separated the disciples from them, daily giving talks in the school auditorium of Tyrannus. (**Acts of Apostles 19:9**)

- While God judges those outside? Remove the wicked man from among yourselves. (**1 Corinthians 5:13**)

- And yet do not be considering him as an enemy, but continue admonishing him as a brother. (**2 Thessalonians 3:15**)
