- Share with the holy ones according to their needs. Follow the course of hospitality. **(Romans 12:13)**
- But hospitable, a lover of goodness, sound in mind, righteous, loyal, self-controlled. **(Titus 1:8)**
- However, I have all **things** in full and have an abundance. I am filled, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the **things** from **YOU**, a sweet-smelling odor, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to **God**. **(Philippians 4:18)**
- And Yehowah began to smell a restful odor, and so Yehowah said in his heart; Never again shall I call down evil upon the ground on man's account, because the inclination of the heart of man is bad from his youth up, and never again shall I deal every living thing a blow just as I have done. **(Genesis 8:21)**
- You should by all means give to him, and your heart should not be stingy in your giving to him, because on this account Yehowah your **God** will bless you in every deed of yours and in every undertaking of yours. **(Deuteronomy 15:10)**
- Ask your own young men, and they will tell you, that my young men may find favor in your eyes, because it was upon a **good** day that we came. Just give, please, whatever your hand may find to your servants and to your son David. **(1 Samuel 25:8)**
- Further, he apportioned to all the people, to the whole crowd of Israel, man as **well** as woman, to each one a ring-shaped cake of bread and a date cake and a raisin cake, after which all the people went each to his own house. **(2 Samuel 6:19)**

- And Barzillai was very old, being eighty years of age, and he himself supplied the king with food while he was dwelling in Mahanaim, for he was a very great man. (2 Samuel 19:32)
- At this Elisha said to her; What shall I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house? To this she said; Your maidservant has nothing at all in the house but a spouted jar of oil. (2 Kings 4:2)
- And there was a man that came from Baal-shalishah, and he came bringing to the man of the true God bread of the first ripe fruits, twenty barley loaves, and new grain in his bread bag. Then he said; Give it to the people that they may eat. (2 Kings 4:42)
- Trust in Yehowah and do good, Reside in the earth, and deal with faithfulness. (Psalms 37:3)
- The man is good who is gracious and is lending. He sustains his affairs with justice. (Psalms 112:5)
- He that is showing favor to the lowly one is lending to Yehowah, and his treatment He will repay to him. (Proverbs 19:17)
- He that is giving to the one of little means will have no want, but he that is hiding his eyes will get many curses. (Proverbs 28:27)
- Her palm she has stretched out to the afflicted one, and her hands she has thrust out to the poor one. (Proverbs 31:20)
- And let justice roll forth just like waters, and righteousness like a constantly flowing torrent. (Amos 5:24)
- True, they have been pleased to do so, and yet they were debtors to them, for if the nations have shared in their spiritual things, they also owe it to minister publicly to these with things for the fleshly body. (Romans 15:27)
- In this way, too, the Lord ordained for those proclaiming the Good News to live by means of the Good News. (1 Corinthians 9:14)
- Let each one do just as he has resolved in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. (2 Corinthians 9:7)
- Through the proof that this ministry gives, they glorify God because YOU are submissive to the Good News about the Christ, as YOU publicly declare YOU are, and because YOU are generous in YOUR contribution to them and to all. (2 Corinthians 9:13)

- Moreover, let anyone who is being orally taught the word share in all **good things** with the one who gives **such** oral teaching. (**Galatians 6:6**)
- Carefully supply Zenas, who is versed in the Law, and Apollos for their trip, that they may not lack anything. (**Titus 3:13**)
