~ **Paul ... Teaching ... Romans 6:14 For sin must not be master over **YOU**, seeing that **YOU** are not under Law but under undeserved kindness.

- But now we have been discharged from the Law, because we have died to that by which we were being held fast, that we might be slaves in a new sense by the spirit, and not in the old sense by the written code. **(Romans 7:6)**
- Furthermore, if **YOU** are being led by spirit, **YOU** are not **under Law**. **(Galatians 5:18)**
- And blotted out the handwritten document against us, which consisted of decrees and which was in opposition to us, and He has taken it out of the way by nailing it to the torture stake. **(Colossians 2:14)**
- Because the Law was given through Moses, the **undeserved kindness** and the truth came to be through Jesus Christ. **(John 1:17)**
- And **YOU** will know the truth, and the truth will set **YOU** free. **(John 8:32)**
- So, my brothers, **YOU** also were made dead to the Law through the body of the Christ, that **YOU** might become another's, the one's who was raised up from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God. **(Romans 7:4)**
- All things are Lawful for me, but not all things are advantageous. All things are Lawful for me, but I will not let myself be brought **under** authority by anything. **(1 Corinthians 6:12)**

- And so to the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might gain Jews, to those **under Law** I became as **under Law**, though I myself am not **under Law**, that I might gain those **under Law**. (**1 Corinthians 9:20**)
- All things are Lawful, but not all things are advantageous. All things are Lawful, but not all things build up. (**1 Corinthians 10:23**)
- Now Yehowah is the Spirit, and where the spirit of Yehowah is, there is freedom. (**2 Corinthians 3:17**)
- Wherefore, brothers, we are children, not of a servant girl, but of the free woman. (**Galatians 4:31**)
