Ephesians 5:18· **Also, do not be getting drunk with wine, in which there is debauchery, but keep getting filled with spirit.**

- Woe to those who are **getting** up early in the morning that they may seek just intoxicating liquor, who are lingering till late in the evening darkness so that **wine** itself inflames them! (**Isaiah 5:11**)
- Woe to the one giving his companions something to drink, attaching to it your rage and anger, in order to make them **drunk**, for the purpose of looking upon their parts of shame. (**Habakkuk 2:15**)
- And they all became **filled** with Holy Spirit and started to speak with different tongues, just as the **spirit** was granting them to make utterance. (**Acts of Apostles 2:4**)
- Do not drink **wine** or intoxicating liquor, you and your sons with you, when **you** come into the tent of meeting, that **you** may not die. It is a statute to time indefinite for **YOUR** generations. (**Leviticus 10:9**)
- And they must say to the older men of his city; This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious, he is not listening to our voice, being a glutton and a drunkard. (**Deuteronomy 21:20**)
- Later Abigail came in to Nabal, and there he was having a feast in his house like the feast of the king, and Nabal's heart was feeling good within him, and he was as **drunk** as could be, and she did not tell him a thing, small or great, until the morning light. (**1 Samuel 25:36**)
- On the seventh day, when the king's heart was in a merry mood with **wine**, he said to Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha and Abagtha, Zethar and Carkas, the seven court officials that were ministering to the person of King Ahasuerus. (**Esther 1:10**)
- Wine is a ridiculer, intoxicating liquor is boisterous, and everyone going astray by it is not wise. (**Proverbs 20:1**)
