Romans 12:9 Let **YOUR** love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is wicked, cling to what is good.

- Love is long-suffering and kind. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, does not get puffed up. (**1 Corinthians 13:4**)
- Really the objective of this mandate is **love** out of a clean heart and out of a **good** conscience and out of faith **without hypocrisy**. (**1 Timothy 1:5**)
- But the wisdom from above is first of all chaste, then peaceable, reasonable, ready to obey, full of mercy and **good** fruits, not making partial distinctions, not hypocritical. (**James 3:17**)
- Now that **YOU** have purified **YOUR** souls by **YOUR** obedience to the truth with unhypocritical brotherly affection as the result, **love** one another intensely from the heart. (**1 Peter 1:22**)
- O **YOU** lovers of Yehowah, hate **what** is bad. He is guarding the souls of his loyal ones, out of the hand of the **wicked** ones he delivers them. (**Psalms 97:10**)
- The fear of Yehowah means the hating of bad. Self-exaltation and pride and the bad way and the perverse mouth I have hated. (**Proverbs 8:13**)
- Turn away from **what** is bad, and do **what** is **good**, seek to find peace, and pursue it. (**Psalms 34:14**)
- You loved righteousness, and you hated Lawlessness. That is why God, your God, anointed you with the oil of exultation more than your partners. (**Hebrews 1:9**)
- But he did **what** was bad, for he had not firmly established his heart to search for Yehowah. (**2 Chronicles 12:14**)

- No boasters may take their stand in front of your eyes. You do hate all those practicing **what** is hurtful. (**Psalms 5:5**)
- I shall not set in front of my eyes any good-for-nothing thing. The doing of those who fall away I have hated, it does not **cling** to me. (**Psalms 101:3**)
- Owing to your orders I behave with understanding. That is why I have hated every false path. (**Psalms 119:104**)
- Falsehood I have hated, and I do keep detesting it. Your Law I have loved. (**Psalms 119:163**)
- Do not incline to the right hand or to the left. Remove your foot from **what** is bad. (**Proverbs 4:27**)
- A time to **love** and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace. (**Ecclesiastes 3:8**)
- Butter and honey he will eat by the time that he knows how to reject the bad and choose the **good**. (**Isaiah 7:15**)
- Happy is the mortal man that does this, and the son of mankind that lays hold of it, keeping the Sabbath in order not to profane it, and keeping his hand in order not to do any kind of badness. (**Isaiah 56:2**)
- A sword **you** have feared, and a sword I shall bring upon **you**, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 11:8**)
- And **you** people will certainly say; Why is it that the son does not have to bear anything because of the error of the father? Now as regards the son, justice and righteousness he has executed, all the statutes of mine he has kept and he keeps doing them. He will positively keep living. (**Ezekiel 18:19**)
- Hate **what** is bad, and **love what** is **good**, and give justice a place in the gate. It may be that Yehowah the God of armies will show favor to the remaining ones of Joseph. (**Amos 5:15**)
- It does not rejoice over unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth. (**1 Corinthians 13:6**)
- By purity, by knowledge, by long-suffering, by kindness, by Holy Spirit, by **love** free from **hypocrisy**. (**2 Corinthians 6:6**)
- So, then, brothers, stand firm and maintain **YOUR** hold on the traditions that **you** were taught, whether it was through a verbal message or through a letter of ours. (**2 Thessalonians 2:15**)

- Little children, let us **love**, neither in word nor with the tongue, but in deed and truth. (**1 John 3:18**)
- Beloved one, be an imitator, not of **what** is bad, but of **what** is **good**. He that does **good** originates with God. He that does bad has not seen God. (**3 John 1:11**)
