

TRUTH - WE HAVE RENOUNCED THE UNDERHANDED THINGS

~ **Paul ... Teaching ... Truth** - We have renounced the underhanded things of which to be ashamed, we do not walk with cunning nor adulterate the word of God, rather we make the truth manifest recommending ourselves to every human conscience in God's sight. (2 Corinthians 4:2) ^[11] - References

2 Corinthians 4:2 But we have renounced the underhanded things of which to be ashamed, not walking with cunning, neither adulterating the word of God, but by making the truth manifest recommending ourselves to every human conscience in the sight of God.

- What, then, was the fruit that **you** used to have at that time? Things of which **you** are now **ashamed**. For the end of those **things** is death. (**Romans 6:21**)
- We are, for we are not peddlers of the **word** of **God** as many men are, but as out of sincerity, yes, as sent from **God**, under God's view, in company with Christ, we are speaking. (**2 Corinthians 2:17**)
- In no way are we giving any cause for stumbling, that our ministry might not be found fault with. (**2 Corinthians 6:3**)
- Thus we are avoiding having any man find fault with us in connection with this liberal contribution to be administered by us. (**2 Corinthians 8:20**)
- As we have said above, I also now say again; Whoever it is that is declaring to **you** as Good News something beyond what **you** accepted, let him be accursed. (**Galatians 1:9**)
- But in every way we recommend ourselves as God's ministers, by the endurance of much, by tribulations, by cases of need, by difficulties. (**2 Corinthians 6:4**)
- So it followed in the morning that here it was Leah! Consequently he said to Laban; What is this you have done to me? Was it not for Rachel that I served with you? So why have you tricked me? (**Genesis 29:25**)

- So Judah said; Let her take them for herself, in order, that we may not fall into contempt. At any rate, I have sent this kid, but you, you never found her. (**Genesis 38:23**)
- Knowing, therefore, the fear of the Lord, we keep persuading men, but we have been made **manifest** to **God**. However, I hope that we have been made **manifest** also to **YOUR consciences**. (**2 Corinthians 5:11**)
- For this very cause I am also suffering these **things**, but I am not **ashamed**. For I know the one whom I have believed, and I am confident he is able to guard what I have laid up in trust with him until that day. (**2 Timothy 1:12**)
- I rejoice very much because I have found certain ones of your children **walking** in the **truth**, just as we received commandment from the Father. (**2 John 1:4**)
