

VENGEANCE - DO NOT AVENGE YOURSELVES BUT YIELD TO YEHOWAH

Romans 12:19· Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but yield place to the wrath, for it is written: Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says Yehowah.

- For we know him that said: **Vengeance is mine, I will** recompense. And again: Yehowah **will** judge his people. **(Hebrews 10:30)**
- However, I say to **YOU**; Do not resist him that is wicked, but whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other also to him **(Matthew 5:39)**
- You must not take vengeance nor have a grudge against the sons of your people, and you must love your fellow as yourself. I am Yehowah. **(Leviticus 19:18)**
- Vengeance is **mine**, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot **will** move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. **(Deuteronomy 32:35)**
- O Yehowah our God, you yourself answered them. A God granting pardon you proved to be to them, and executing vengeance against their notorious deeds. **(Psalms 99:8)**
- Yehowah is a God exacting exclusive devotion and taking vengeance, Yehowah is taking vengeance and is disposed to rage. Yehowah is taking vengeance against his adversaries, and he is resentful toward his enemies. **(Nahum 1:2)**
- For we know him that said: **Vengeance is mine, I will** recompense. And again: Yehowah **will** judge his people. **(Hebrews 10:30)**
- Here you are actually driving me this day from off the surface of the ground, and from your face I shall be concealed, and I must

become a wanderer and fugitive on the earth, and it is certain that anyone finding me **will** kill me. (**Genesis 4:14**)

· Into their intimate group do not come, O my soul. With their congregation do not become united, O my disposition, because in their anger they killed men, and in their arbitrariness they hamstrung bulls. (**Genesis 49:6**)

· Then Joseph said to them; Do not be afraid, for am I in the **place** of God? (**Genesis 50:19**)

· And Yehowah your God **will** certainly put all these oaths upon your enemies and those who hate you, who have persecuted you. (**Deuteronomy 30:7**)

· However, Saul said; Not a man should be put to death on this day, because today Yehowah has performed salvation in Israel. (**1 Samuel 11:13**)

· Accordingly David dispersed his men with these words, and he did not allow them to rise up against Saul. As for Saul, he rose up from the cave and kept going on his way. (**1 Samuel 24:7**)

· May Yehowah judge between me and you, and Yehowah must take vengeance for me from you, but my own hand **will** not come to be upon you. (**1 Samuel 24:12**)

· And now, my lord, as Yehowah is living and as your soul is living, Yehowah has held you back from entering into bloodguilt and having your own hand come to your salvation. And now let your enemies and those seeking injury to my lord become like Nabal. (**1 Samuel 25:26**)

· And blessed be your sensibleness, and blessed be you who have restrained me this day from entering into bloodguilt and having my own hand come to my salvation. (**1 Samuel 25:33**)

· And David went on to say; As Yehowah is living, Yehowah himself **will** deal him a blow, or his day **will** come and he **will** have to die, or down into battle he **will** go, and he **will** certainly be swept away. (**1 Samuel 26:10**)

· As for Joab and Abishai his brother, they killed Abner over the fact that he had put Asahel their brother to death at Gibeon in the battle. (**2 Samuel 3:30**)

· Eventually they came bringing the head of Ish-bosheth to David at Hebron and said to the king; Here is the head of Ish-bosheth the son of Saul your enemy who looked for your soul, but Yehowah gives to

my lord the king revenge this day upon Saul and his offspring. (2 Samuel 4:8)

- Finally Abishai the son of Zeruah said to the king; Why should this dead dog call down evil upon my lord the king? Let me go over, please, and take off his head. (2 Samuel 16:9)
- And you must strike down the house of Ahab your lord, and I must avenge the blood of my servants the prophets and the blood of all the servants of Yehowah at the hand of Jezebel. (2 Kings 9:7)
- Who **will** tell him of his way to his very face? And for what he himself has done who **will** reward him? (Job 21:31)
- The true God is the Giver of acts of vengeance to me, and he subdues the peoples under me. (Psalms 18:47)
- He **will repay** the bad to my foes, in your trueness silence them. (Psalms 54:5)
- Why should the nations say; Where is their God? Among the nations let there be known before our eyes the avenging of the blood of your servants that has been shed. (Psalms 79:10)
- O God of acts of vengeance, Yehowah, O God of acts of vengeance, beam forth! (Psalms 94:1)
- Do not say; Just as he did to me, so I am going to do to him. I shall **repay** to each one according to his acting. (Proverbs 24:29)
- Therefore the utterance of the true Lord, Yehowah of armies, the Powerful One of Israel, is; Aha! I shall relieve myself of my adversaries, and I **will** avenge myself on my enemies. (Isaiah 1:24)
- For Yehowah has a day of vengeance, a year of retributions for the legal case over Zion. (Isaiah 34:8)
- Say to those who are anxious at heart; Be strong. Do not be afraid. Look! **YOUR** own God **will** come with vengeance itself, God even with a repayment. He himself **will** come and save **you** people. (Isaiah 35:4)
- You ought to uncover your nakedness. Also, your reproach ought to be seen. Vengeance is what I shall take, and I shall not meet any man kindly. (Isaiah 47:3)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am stretching out my hand against the Philistines, and I **will** cut

off the Cherethites and destroy the rest of the seacoast. (**Ezekiel 25:16**)

- See that no one renders injury for injury to anyone else, but always pursue what is good toward one another and to all others. (**1 Thessalonians 5:15**)
- This takes into account that it is righteous on God's part to **repay** tribulation to those who make tribulation for **you**. (**2 Thessalonians 1:6**)
- For an overseer must be free from accusation as God's steward, not self-willed, not prone to **wrath**, not a drunken brawler, not a smiter, not greedy of dishonest gain. (**Titus 1:7**)
- Be glad over her, O heaven, also **you** holy ones and **you** apostles and **you** prophets, because God has judicially exacted punishment for **you** from her! (**Revelation 18:20**)
