Romans 12:17 Return evil for evil to no one. Provide fine things in the sight of all men.

[16] - References

- See that no one renders injury for injury to anyone else, but always pursue what is good toward one another and to all others. (**1 Thessalonians 5:15**)
- When he was being reviled, he did not go reviling in return. When he was suffering, he did not go threatening, but kept on committing himself to the one who judges righteously. (**1 Peter 2:23**)
- Not paying back injury for injury or reviling for reviling, but, to the contrary, bestowing a blessing, because **you** were called to this course, so that **you** might inherit a blessing. (**1 Peter 3:9**)
- When the brothers of Joseph saw that their father was dead, they began to say; It may be that Joseph is harboring animosity against us and he will be sure to repay us for all the **evil** that we have rendered him. (**Genesis 50:15**)
- And she kept lying at his feet until the morning and then got up before anyone could recognize another. He now said; Do not let it be known that a woman came to the threshing floor. (**Ruth 3:14**)
- Accordingly David dispersed his **men** with these words, and he did not allow them to rise up against Saul. As for Saul, he rose up from the cave and kept going on his way. (**1 Samuel 24:7**)
- And he went on to say to David; You are more righteous than I am, for it is you who have rendered me good, and it is I who have rendered you **evil**. (**1 Samuel 24:17**)
- Now in the case where a man finds his enemy, will he send him away on a good road? So Yehowah himself will reward you with good, due to the fact that this day you have done it to me. (**1 Samuel 24:19**)

- It is unthinkable, on my part, from Yehowah's standpoint, to thrust my hand out against the anointed of Yehowah! So now take, please, the spear that is at his head and the water jug, and let us get on our way. (**1 Samuel 26:11**)
- He has not slandered with his tongue. To his companion he has done nothing bad, and no reproach has he taken up against his intimate acquaintance. (**Psalms 15:3**)
- Do not say; I will pay back evil! Hope in Yehowah, and he will save you. (**Proverbs 20:22**)
- Do not say; Just as he did to me, so I am going to do to him. I shall repay to each one according to his acting. (**Proverbs 24:29**)
- However, I say to **you**; Do not resist him that is wicked, but whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other also to him (**Matthew 5:39**)
- Really, then, it means altogether a defeat for **you** that **you** are having Lawsuits with one another. Why do **you** not rather let yourselves be wronged? Why do **you** not rather let yourselves be defrauded? (**1 Corinthians 6:7**)
- So that **you** may be walking decently as regards people outside and not be needing anything. (**1 Thessalonians 4:12**)
- Maintain **your** conduct **fine** among the nations, that, in the thing in which they are speaking against **you** as evildoers, they may as a result of **your fine** works of which they are eyewitnesses glorify God in the day for his inspection. (**1 Peter 2:12**)
