

Nahum 1:2· **Yehowah is a God¹ exacting exclusive devotion and taking vengeance, Yehowah is taking vengeance and is disposed to² rage. Yehowah is taking vengeance against his adversaries, and he is resentful toward his enemies.**

- You must not bow down to them nor be induced to serve them, because I **Yehowah** your **God** am a **God exacting exclusive devotion**, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (**Exodus 20:5**)
- For **Yehowah** your **God** is a consuming fire, a **God exacting exclusive devotion**. (**Deuteronomy 4:24**)
- Then Joshua said to the people; **You** are not able to serve **Yehowah**, for he is a holy **God**, he is a **God exacting exclusive devotion**. He will not pardon **YOUR** revolting and **YOUR** sins. (**Joshua 24:19**)
- Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot will move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. (**Deuteronomy 32:35**)
- And in anger and in **rage** I will execute **vengeance** upon the nations that have not obeyed. (**Micah 5:15**)
- For it is God's minister to you for your good. But if you are doing what is bad, be in fear, for it is not without purpose that it bears the sword, for it is God's minister, an avenger to express wrath upon the one practicing what is bad. (**Romans 13:4**)
- For we know him that said; Vengeance is mine, I will recompense, and again; Yehowah will judge his people. (**Hebrews 10:30**)
- In accordance with the dealings he will reward correspondingly, **rage** to his **adversaries**, due treatment to his **enemies**. To the islands he will recompense due treatment. (**Isaiah 59:18**)

- The burning anger of **Yehowah** will not turn back until he will have executed and until he will have carried out the ideas of his heart. In the final part of the days **YOU** people will give **YOUR** consideration to it. (**Jeremiah 30:24**)
- However, if our unrighteousness brings God's righteousness to the fore, what shall we say? **God** is not unjust when he vents his wrath, is he? I am speaking as a man does. (**Romans 3:5**)
- If I do indeed sharpen my glittering sword, and my hand takes hold on judgment, I will pay back **vengeance** to my **adversaries** and render retribution to those who intensely hate me. (**Deuteronomy 32:41**)
- Their **enemies** I would easily subdue, and **against** their **adversaries** I would turn my hand. (**Psalms 81:14**)
- Before him a very fire goes, and it consumes his **adversaries** all around. (**Psalms 97:3**)
- Your hand will be high above your **adversaries**, and all **enemies** of yours will be cut off. (**Micah 5:9**)
- But according to your hardness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath and of the revealing of God's righteous judgment. (**Romans 2:5**)
- **Yehowah** knows how to deliver people of godly **devotion** out of trial, but to reserve unrighteous people for the day of judgment to be cut off. (**2 Peter 2:9**)
- Take **vengeance** for the sons of Israel upon the Midianites. Afterward you will be gathered to your people. (**Numbers 31:2**)
- You must not bow down to them or be led to serve them, because I **Yehowah** your **God** am a **God exacting exclusive devotion**, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons and upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (**Deuteronomy 5:9**)
- For **Yehowah** your **God** in your midst is a **God exacting exclusive devotion**, for fear the anger of **Yehowah** your **God** may blaze **against** you and he must annihilate you from off the surface of the ground. (**Deuteronomy 6:15**)

- But repaying to his face the one who hates him by destroying him. He will not hesitate **toward** the one who hates him, he will repay him to his face. (**Deuteronomy 7:10**)
- May **Yehowah** judge between me and you, and **Yehowah** must take **vengeance** for me from you, but my own hand will not come to be upon you. (**1 Samuel 24:12**)
- And he got on his way. Later a lion found him on the road and put him to death, and his dead body came to be thrown onto the road. And the ass was standing beside it, and the lion was standing beside the dead body. (**1 Kings 13:24**)
- Finally he turned behind him and saw them and called down evil upon them in the name of **Yehowah**. Then two she-bears came out from the woods and went tearing to pieces forty-two children of their number. (**2 Kings 2:24**)
- And the king himself had appointed the adjutant upon whose hand he was supporting himself to have charge of the gateway, and the people kept trampling him in the gateway, so that he died, just as the man of the true **God** had spoken, when he spoke at the time that the king came down to him. (**2 Kings 7:17**)
- On the thirteenth day of the month Adar, and there was a rest on the fourteenth day of it, and there was a making of it a day of banqueting and of rejoicing. (**Esther 9:17**)
- The true **God** is the Giver of acts of **vengeance** to me, and he subdues the peoples under me. (**Psalms 18:47**)
- O **God** of acts of **vengeance**, **Yehowah**, O **God** of acts of **vengeance**, beam forth! (**Psalms 94:1**)
- And **Yehowah** will certainly make the dignity of his voice to be heard and will make the descending of his arm to be seen, in the raging of anger and the flame of a devouring fire and cloudburst and rainstorm and hailstones. (**Isaiah 30:30**)
- For **Yehowah** has indignation **against** all the nations, and **rage against** all their army. He must devote them to destruction, he must give them to the slaughter. (**Isaiah 34:2**)
- Like a mighty man **Yehowah** himself will go forth. Like a warrior he will awaken zeal. He will shout, yes, he will let out a war cry, over his **enemies** he will show himself mightier. (**Isaiah 42:13**)

- **Should I not take an accounting because of these very things? Is the utterance of **Yehowah**. Or upon a nation that is like this should not my soul avenge itself? (**Jeremiah 5:9**)**
- **And I will judge you with the judgments of adulteresses and women shedding blood, and I will give you the blood of **rage** and jealousy. (**Ezekiel 16:38**)**
- **And I will bring my **vengeance** on Edom by the hand of my people Israel, and they must do in Edom according to my anger and according to my **rage**, and they will have to know what my **vengeance** is, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 25:14**)**
- **And I will execute in them great acts of **vengeance**, with raging reproofs, and they will have to know that I am **Yehowah** when I bring my **vengeance** on them. (**Ezekiel 25:17**)**
- **And it must occur in that day, in the day when Gog comes in upon the soil of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, that my **rage** will come up into my nose. (**Ezekiel 38:18**)**
- **And the angel who was speaking with me went on to say to me; Call out, saying, This is what **Yehowah** of armies has said; I have been jealous for Jerusalem and for Zion with great jealousy. (**Zechariah 1:14**)**
- **This is what **Yehowah** of armies has said, I will be jealous for Zion with great jealousy, and with great **rage** I will be jealous for her. (**Zechariah 8:2**)**
- **Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but yield place to the wrath, for it is written: Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says Yehowah. (**Romans 12:19**)**
