

**Nahum 1:7** Yehowah is good, a stronghold in the day of distress. And he is cognizant of those seeking refuge in him.

[15] - References:

- Good and upright is Yehowah. That is why he instructs sinners in the way. (**Psalms 25:8**)
- Give thanks to Yehowah, O **you** people, for he is **good**, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (**Psalms 136:1**)
- He said to him; Why do you ask me about what is **good**? One there is that is **good**. If, though, you want to enter into life, observe the commandments continually. (**Matthew 19:17**)
- Yehowah is my crag and my **stronghold** and the Provider of escape for me. My God is my rock. I shall take **refuge** in him, my shield and my horn of salvation, my secure height. (**Psalms 18:2**)
- I will say to Yehowah; You are my **refuge** and my **stronghold**, my God, in whom I will trust. (**Psalms 91:2**)
- The name of Yehowah is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (**Proverbs 18:10**)
- For you have become a **stronghold** to the lowly one, a **stronghold** to the poor one in the **distress** that he has, a **refuge** from the rainstorm, a shade from the heat, when the blast of the tyrannical ones is like a rainstorm against a wall. (**Isaiah 25:4**)
- God is for us a **refuge** and strength, a help that is readily to be found during distresses. (**Psalms 46:1**)
- And call me in the **day** of **distress**. I shall rescue you, and you will glorify me. (**Psalms 50:15**)
- He will call upon me, and I shall answer him. I shall be with him in **distress**. I shall rescue him and glorify him. (**Psalms 91:15**)
- Thus the sons of Israel were humbled at that time, but the sons of Judah proved superior because they leaned upon Yehowah the God of their forefathers. (**2 Chronicles 13:18**)
- Yehowah is **good** to all, and his mercies are over all his works. (**Psalms 145:9**)

- **O Yehowah, show us favor. In you we have hoped. Become our arm every morning, yes, our salvation in the time of **distress**. (Isaiah 33:2)**
- **O Yehowah my strength and my **stronghold**, and my place for flight in the **day** of **distress**, to you the nations themselves will come from the ends of the earth, and they will say; Indeed our forefathers came to possess sheer falsehood, vanity and things in which there was nothing beneficial. (Jeremiah 16:19)**
- **But if anyone loves God, this one is known by him. (1 Corinthians 8:3)**
