

**~ Jehoram (36)**

**1 Kings 22:50.** Finally Jehoshaphat lay down with his forefathers and was buried with his forefathers in the City of David his forefather and **Jehoram his son began to reign** in place of him

**2 Kings 1:17.** And he gradually died according to the word of Yehowah that **Elijah had spoken and Jehoram began to reign** in place of him in the second year of Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah because he had not come to have a son

**2 Kings 3:1.** **As for Jehoram the son of Ahab** he became king over Israel in Samaria in the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah and he continued to reign for twelve years

**2 Kings 3:6.** **Consequently King Jehoram went out on that day from Samaria and mustered all Israel**

**2 Kings 8:16.** And in **the fifth year of Jehoram the son of Ahab** the king of Israel while Jehoshaphat was king of Judah Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah became king

**2 Kings 8:21.** **Consequently Jehoram passed over to Zair** also all the chariots with him And it came about that he himself rose up by night and got to strike down the Edomites that were surrounding him and the chiefs of the chariots and the people went fleeing to their tents

**2 Kings 8:23.** And the rest **of the affairs of Jehoram and all that he did** are they not written in the book of the affairs of the days of the kings of Judah

**2 Kings 8:24.** **Finally Jehoram lay down with his forefathers and was buried with his forefathers in the City of David** And Ahaziah his son began to reign in place of him

- 2 Kings 8:25. **In the twelfth year of Jehoram the son of Ahab** the king of Israel Ahaziah the son of Jehoram the king of Judah became king
- 2 Kings 8:28. **Accordingly he went with Jehoram the son of Ahab** to the war against Hazael the king of Syria at Ramoth-gilead but the Syrians struck down Jehoram
- 2 Kings 8:29. **So Jehoram the king returned to** get healed at Jezreel from the wounds that the Syrians got to inflict upon him at Ramah when he fought Hazael the king of Syria As for Ahaziah the son of Jehoram the king of Judah he went down to see Jehoram the son of Ahab in Jezreel for he was sick
- 2 Kings 9:14. **And Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi proceeded to conspire against Jehoram And Jehoram himself had** happened to be keeping guard at Ramoth-gilead he with all Israel because of Hazael the king of Syria
- 2 Kings 9:15. **Later Jehoram the king returned to** get healed at Jezreel from the wounds that the Syrians got to inflict upon him when he fought Hazael the king of Syria Jehu now said If YOUR soul agrees do not let anyone go out in escape from the city to go and make report in Jezreel
- 2 Kings 9:16. **And Jehu began to ride and go to Jezreel for Jehoram was lying there and** Ahaziah the king of Judah himself had gone down to see Jehoram
- 2 Kings 9:17. **And the watchman was standing upon the tower in Jezreel and he got to see the heaving mass of Jehu's men as he was coming and he at once said There is a heaving mass of men that I am seeing At that Jehoram said Take a cavalryman and send him to meet them and let him say Is there peace**
- 2 Kings 9:21. **At that Jehoram said Hitch up So** his war chariot was hitched up and Jehoram the king of Israel and Ahaziah the king of Judah went out each in his own war chariot As they continued

on out to meet Jehu they got to find him in the tract of land of Naboth the Jezreelite

2 Kings 9:22. And it came about **that as soon as Jehoram saw Jehu he immediately** said Is there peace Jehu But he said What peace could there be as long as there are the fornications of Jezebel your mother and her many sorceries

2 Kings 9:23. **At once Jehoram made a turn with** his hands that he might flee and said to Ahaziah There is trickery Ahaziah

2 Kings 9:24. And Jehu himself filled his hand with a bow **and proceeded to shoot Jehoram between the arms so** that the arrow came out at his heart and he collapsed in his war chariot

2 Kings 9:29. And it was in **the eleventh year of Jehoram the son of Ahab** that Ahaziah had become king over Judah

2 Kings 11:2. However Jehosheba **the daughter of King Jehoram the sister of Ahaziah** took Jehoash the son of Ahaziah and stole him from among the sons of the king that were to be put to death even him and his nursing woman into the inner room for the couches and they kept him concealed from the face of Athaliah and he was not put to death

2 Kings 12:18. At that Jehoash the king of Judah took all the holy **offerings that Jehoshaphat and Jehoram and Ahaziah his forefathers** the kings of Judah had sanctified and his own holy offerings and all the gold to be found in the treasures of the house of Yehowah and the house of the king and sent them to Hazael the king of Syria So he withdrew from against Jerusalem

1 Chronicles 3:11.. **Jehoram his son Ahaziah his son Jehoash his son**

2 Chronicles 17:8.. and with them the Levites Shemaiah and Nethaniah and Zebadiah and Asahel and Shemiramoth and Jehonathan and Adonijah and Tobijah and Tob-adonijah the Levites and **with them Elishama and Jehoram the priests**

- 2 Chronicles 21:1. **Finally Jehoshaphat lay down with his forefathers and was buried with his forefathers in the City of David and Jehoram his son began to reign in place of him**
- 2 Chronicles 21:3. **Consequently their father gave them many gifts in silver and in gold and in choice things along with fortified cities in Judah but the kingdom he gave to Jehoram for he was the firstborn**
- 2 Chronicles 21:4. **When Jehoram rose up over the kingdom of his father he proceeded to make his position strong and so he killed all his brothers with the sword and also some of the princes of Israel**
- 2 Chronicles 21:5. **Thirty-two years old was Jehoram when he began to reign and for eight years he reigned in Jerusalem**
- 2 Chronicles 21:9. **So Jehoram together with his chiefs passed over and also all the chariots with him And it came about that he rose up by night and went striking down the Edomites that were surrounding him and also the chiefs of the chariots**
- 2 Chronicles 21:16. **Accordingly Yehowah aroused against Jehoram the spirit of the Philistines and the Arabs that were by the side of the Ethiopians**
- 2 Chronicles 22:1. **Then the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in place of him for the marauder band that came with the Arabs to the camp had killed all the older ones and Ahaziah the son of Jehoram began to reign as king of Judah**
- 2 Chronicles 22:5. **It was also in their counsel that he walked so that he went with Jehoram the son of Ahab the king of Israel to the war against Hazael the king of Syria at Ramoth-gilead at which the shooters got to strike Jehoram**
- 2 Chronicles 22:6. **Hence he returned to get healed at Jezreel from the wounds that they had inflicted upon him at Ramah when he**

**fought Hazael the king of Syria As for Azariah the son of Jehoram the king of Judah he went down to see Jehoram the son of Ahab in Jezreel for he was sick**

**2 Chronicles 22:7. But it was from God that the downfall of Ahaziah occurred by his coming to Jehoram and when he came he went out with Jehoram to Jehu the grandson of Nimshi whom Yehowah had anointed to cut off the house of Ahab**

**2 Chronicles 22:11. However Jehoshabeath the daughter of the king took Jehoash the son of Ahaziah and stole him away from among the sons of the king that were to be put to death and put him and his nursing woman in the inner room for the couches And Jehoshabeath the daughter of King Jehoram the wife of Jehoiada the priest for she herself happened to be the sister of Ahaziah kept him concealed because of Athaliah and she did not put him to death**
