- Genesis 5:11. **So all the days of Enosh amounted to nine hundred and five years and he died**
- Genesis 5:12. **And Kenan lived on for seventy years Then he became father to Mahalalel**
- Genesis 5:13. **And after his fathering Mahalalel Kenan continued to live eight hundred and forty years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**
- Genesis 5:14. **So all the days of Kenan amounted to nine hundred and ten years and he died**
- Genesis 5:15. **And Mahalalel lived on for sixty-five years Then he became father to Jared**
- Genesis 5:16. **And after his fathering Jared Mahalalel continued to live eight hundred and thirty years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**
- Genesis 5:17. **So all the days of Mahalalel amounted to eight hundred and ninety-five years and he died**
- Genesis 5:18. **And Jared lived on for a hundred and sixty-two years Then he became father to Enoch**
- Genesis 5:19. **And after his fathering Enoch Jared continued to live eight hundred years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**
- Genesis 5:20. **So all the days of Jared amounted to nine hundred and sixty-two years and he died**
- Genesis 5:21. **And Enoch lived on for sixty-five years Then he became father to Methuselah**

Genesis 5:22. **And after his fathering Methuselah Enoch went on walking with the true God three hundred years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**

Genesis 5:23. **So all the days of Enoch amounted to three hundred and sixty-five years**

Genesis 5:25. **And Methuselah lived on for a hundred and eighty-seven years Then he became father to Lamech**

Genesis 5:26. **And after his fathering Lamech Methuselah continued to live seven hundred and eighty-two years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**

Genesis 5:27. **So all the days of Methuselah amounted to nine hundred and sixty-nine years and he died**

Genesis 5:28. **And Lamech lived on for a hundred and eighty-two years Then he became father to a son**

Genesis 5:30. **And after his fathering Noah Lamech continued to live five hundred and ninety-five years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**

Genesis 5:31. **So all the days of Lamech amounted to seven hundred and seventy-seven years and he died**

Genesis 5:32. **And Noah got to be five hundred years old After that Noah became father to Shem Ham and Japheth**

Genesis 6:3. **After that Yehowah said My spirit shall not act toward man indefinitely in that he is also flesh Accordingly his days shall amount to a hundred and twenty years**

Genesis 7:6. **And Noah was six hundred years old when the deluge of waters occurred on the earth**

- Genesis 9:28. **And Noah continued to live three hundred and fifty years after the deluge**
- Genesis 9:29. **So all the days of Noah amounted to nine hundred and fifty years and he died**
- Genesis 11:10. **This is the history of Shem Shem was a hundred years old when he became father to Arpachshad two years after the deluge**
- Genesis 11:11. **And after his fathering Arpachshad Shem continued to live five hundred years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**
- Genesis 11:12. **And Arpachshad lived thirtyfive years Then he became father to Shelah**
- Genesis 11:13. **And after his fathering Shelah Arpachshad continued to live four hundred and three years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**
- Genesis 11:14. **And Shelah lived thirty years Then he became father to Eber**
- Genesis 11:15. **And after his fathering Eber Shelah continued to live four hundred and three years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**
- Genesis 11:16. **And Eber lived on for thirty-four years Then he became father to Peleg**
- Genesis 11:17. **And after his fathering Peleg Eber continued to live four hundred and thirty years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**
- Genesis 11:18. **And Peleg lived on for thirty years Then he became father to Reu**

- Genesis 11:19. **And after his fathering Reu Peleg continued to live two hundred and nine years Meanwhile he became father to sons and daughters**

- Genesis 14:4. **Twelve years they had served Chedorlaomer but the thirteenth year they rebelled**

Genesis 15:13. **And he began to say to Abram You may know for sure that your seed will become an alien resident in a land not theirs and they will have to serve them and these will certainly afflict them for four hundred years**

Genesis 16:3. **Then Sarai Abram's wife took Hagar her Egyptian maidservant at the end of ten years of Abram's dwelling in the land of Canaan and gave her to Abram her husband as his wife**

Genesis 16:16. **And Abram was eighty-six years old at Hagar's bearing Ishmael to Abram**

Genesis 17:1. **When Abram got to be ninety-nine years old then Yehowah appeared to Abram and said to him I am God Almighty Walk before me and prove yourself faultless**

Genesis 17:17. **At this Abraham fell upon his face and began to laugh and to say in his heart Will a man a hundred years old have a child born and will Sarah yes will a woman ninety years old give birth**

Genesis 17:24. **And Abraham was ninety-nine years old when he had the flesh of his foreskin circumcised**

Genesis 17:25. **And Ishmael his son was thirteen years old when he had the flesh of his foreskin circumcised**

Genesis 18:11. **And Abraham and Sarah were old being advanced in years Sarah had stopped having menstruation**

Genesis 21:5. **And Abraham was a hundred years old when Isaac his son was born to him**

Genesis 23:1. **And Sarah's life got to be a hundred and twenty-seven years long They were the years of Sarah's life**

Genesis 24:1. **Now Abraham was old advanced in years and Yehowah had blessed Abraham in everything**

- Genesis 25:7. **And these are the days of the years of Abraham's life which he lived a hundred and seventy-five years**
- Genesis 25:17. **And these are the years of Ishmael's life a hundred and thirty-seven years Then he expired and died and was gathered to his people**
- Genesis 25:20. **And Isaac happened to be forty years old at his taking Rebekah the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Paddanaram the sister of Laban the Syrian as his wife**
- Genesis 25:26. **And after that his brother came out and his hand was holding onto the heel of Esau so he called his name Jacob And Isaac was sixty years old at her giving them birth**
- Genesis 26:34. **And Esau grew to be forty years old Then he took as wife Judith the daughter of Beerli the Hittite and also Basemath the daughter of Elon the Hittite**
- Genesis 29:18. **And Jacob was in love with Rachel So he said I am willing to serve you seven years for Rachel your younger daughter**
- Genesis 29:20. **And Jacob proceeded to serve seven years for Rachel but in his eyes they proved to be like some few days because of his love for her**
- Genesis 29:27. **Celebrate to the full the week of this woman After that there shall be given to you also this other woman for the service that you can serve with me for seven years more**
- Genesis 29:30. **Then he had relations also with Rachel and also expressed more love for Rachel than for Leah and he went serving with him for yet seven years more**
- Genesis 31:38. **These twenty years I have been with you Your female sheep and your she-goats did not suffer abortions and the rams of your flock I never ate**

- Genesis 31:41. **This makes twenty years for me in your house I have served you fourteen years for your two daughters and six years for your flock and you kept changing my wages ten times**
- Genesis 35:28. **And the days of Isaac came to be a hundred and eighty years**
- Genesis 37:2. **This is the history of Jacob Joseph when seventeen years old happened to be tending sheep with his brothers among the flock and being but a boy he was with the sons of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah the wives of his father So Joseph brought a bad report about them to their father**
- Genesis 41:1. **And it came about at the end of two full years that Pharaoh was dreaming and here he was standing by the river Nile**
- Genesis 41:26. **The seven good cows are seven years Likewise the seven good ears of grain are seven years The dream is but one**
- Genesis 41:27. **And the seven skinny and bad cows that came up after them are seven years and the seven empty ears of grain scorched by the east wind will prove to be seven years of famine**
- Genesis 41:29. **Here there are seven years coming with great plenty in all the land of Egypt**
- Genesis 41:30. **But seven years of famine will certainly arise after them and all the plenty in the land of Egypt will certainly be forgotten and the famine will simply consume the land**
- Genesis 41:34. **Let Pharaoh act and appoint overseers over the land and he must take up one fifth of the land of Egypt during the seven years of plenty**
- Genesis 41:35. **And let them collect all the foodstuffs of these coming good years and let them pile up grain under Pharaoh's hand as foodstuffs in the cities and they must safeguard it**



- Genesis 41:36. **And the foodstuffs must serve as a supply for the land for the seven famine years which will develop in the land of Egypt in order that the land may not be cut off by the famine**
- Genesis 41:46. **And Joseph was thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh the king of Egypt Then Joseph went out from before Pharaoh and toured about in all the land of Egypt**
- Genesis 41:47. **And during the seven years of plenty the land went on producing by the handfuls**
- Genesis 41:48. **And he kept collecting all the foodstuffs of the seven years that came upon the land of Egypt and he would put the foodstuffs in the cities The foodstuffs of the field that was round about a city he put in the midst of it**
- Genesis 41:53. **And the seven years of the plenty that had obtained in the land of Egypt gradually ended**
- Genesis 41:54. **and in turn the seven years of the famine started to come just as Joseph had said And the famine developed in all the lands but in all the land of Egypt there was found bread**
- Genesis 45:6. **For this is the second year of the famine in the midst of the earth and there are yet five years in which there will be no plowing time or harvest**
- Genesis 45:11. **And I will supply you with food there for there are yet five years of famine for fear you and your house and everything you have may come to poverty**
- Genesis 47:8. **Pharaoh now said to Jacob How many are the days of the years of your life**
- Genesis 47:9. **So Jacob said to Pharaoh The days of the years of my alien residences are a hundred and thirty years Few and distressing the days of the years of my life have proved and they have not**

reached the days of the years of the lives of my fathers in the days of their alien residences

Genesis 47:28. **And Jacob lived on in the land of Egypt for seventeen years so that Jacob's days the years of his life came to be a hundred and forty-seven years**

Genesis 50:22. **And Joseph continued to dwell in Egypt he and the house of his father and Joseph lived for a hundred and ten years**

Genesis 50:26. **After that Joseph died at the age of a hundred and ten years and they had him embalmed and he was put in a coffin in Egypt**

Exodus 6:16.. **And these are the names of the sons of Levi according to their family descents Gershon and Kohath and Merari And the years of Levi's life were a hundred and thirty-seven years**

Exodus 6:18. **And the sons of Kohath were Amram and Izhar and Hebron and Uzziel And the years of Kohath's life were a hundred and thirty-three years**

Exodus 6:20. **Now Amram took Jochebed his father's sister as his wife Later she bore him Aaron and Moses And the years of Amram's life were a hundred and thirty-seven years**

Exodus 7:7. **And Moses was eighty years old and Aaron was eighty-three years old at the time of their speaking to Pharaoh**

Exodus 12:40. **And the dwelling of the sons of Israel who had dwelt in Egypt was four hundred and thirty years**

Exodus 12:41. **And it came about at the end of the four hundred and thirty years it even came about on this very day that all the armies of Yehowah went out of the land of Egypt**

Exodus 16:35. **And the sons of Israel ate the manna forty years until their coming to a land inhabited** The manna was what they ate until their coming to the frontier of the land of Canaan

Exodus 21:2. **In case you should buy a Hebrew slave he will be a slave six years but in the seventh he will go out as one set free without charge**

Exodus 23:10. **And for six years you are to sow your land with seed and you must gather its produce**

Exodus 30:14. **Everyone passing over to those registered from twenty years old and upward will give Yehowah's contribution**

Exodus 38:26. **The half shekel for an individual was the half of a shekel by the shekel of the holy place for every man who was passing over to those who were registered from twenty years of age and upward amounting to six hundred and three thousand five hundred and fifty**

Leviticus 19:23. **And in case YOU people come into the land and YOU must plant any tree for food YOU must also consider its fruitage impure as its foreskin For three years it will continue uncircumcised for YOU It should not be eaten**

Leviticus 25:3. **Six years you should sow your field with seed and six years you should prune your vineyard and you must gather the land's produce**

Leviticus 25:8. **And you must count for yourself seven sabbaths of years seven times seven years and the days of the seven sabbaths of years must amount to forty-nine years for you**

Leviticus 25:15. **By the number of the years after the Jubilee you should buy from your associate by the number of the years of the crops he should sell to you**

Leviticus 25:16. **In proportion to the great number of years he should increase its purchase value and in proportion to the fewness of years he should reduce its purchase value because the number of the crops is what he is selling to you**

Leviticus 25:21. **in that case I shall certainly command my blessing for YOU in the sixth year and it must yield its crop for three years**

Leviticus 25:27. **he must also calculate the years from when he sold it and he must return what money remains over to the man to whom he made the sale and he must return to his possession**

Leviticus 25:50. **And he must reckon with his purchaser from the year he sold himself to him till the Jubilee year and the money of his sale must correspond with the number of years The way workdays of a hired laborer are reckoned he should continue with him**

Leviticus 25:51. **If there are yet many years he should in proportion to them pay his repurchase price over from the money of his purchase**

Leviticus 25:52. **But if only a few remain of the years until the Jubilee year he must then make a calculation for himself In proportion to the years of his he should pay over his repurchase price**

Leviticus 27:3. **and the estimated value has to be of a male from twenty years old up to sixty years old the estimated value must then become fifty shekels of silver by the shekel of the holy place**

Leviticus 27:5. **And if the age is from five years old up to twenty years old the estimated value of the male must then become twenty shekels and for the female ten shekels**

Leviticus 27:6. **And if the age is from a month old up to five years old the estimated value of the male must then become five shekels of silver and for the female the estimated value must be three shekels of silver**

Leviticus 27:7. **Now if the age is from sixty years old upward if it is a male the estimated value must then become fifteen shekels and for the female ten shekels**

Leviticus 27:18. **And if it is after the Jubilee that he sanctifies his field the priest must then calculate for him the price in proportion to the years that are left over until the next year of Jubilee and a deduction should be made from the estimated value**

Numbers 1:3.. **from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army in Israel YOU should register them according to their armies you and Aaron**

Numbers 1:18. **And they congregated all the assembly on the first day of the second month that they might have their descent acknowledged as regards their families in the house of their fathers by the number of the names from twenty years old upward head by head of them**

Numbers 1:20. **And the sons of Reuben Israel's firstborn their births according to their families in the house of their fathers came to be by the number of names head by head of them all the males from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army**

Numbers 1:22. **Of the sons of Simeon their births according to their families in the house of their fathers those registered ones of his by the number of names head by head of them all the males from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army**

Numbers 1:24. **Of the sons of Gad their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army**

Numbers 1:26. **Of the sons of Judah their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army**

- Numbers 1:28.** Of the sons of Issachar their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army
- Numbers 1:30.** Of the sons of Zebulun their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army
- Numbers 1:32.** Of the sons of Joseph of the sons of Ephraim their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army
- Numbers 1:34.** Of the sons of Manasseh their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army
- Numbers 1:36.** Of the sons of Benjamin their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army
- Numbers 1:38.** Of the sons of Dan their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army
- Numbers 1:40.** Of the sons of Asher their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army
- Numbers 1:42.** Of the sons of Naphtali their births according to their families in the house of their fathers by the number of names from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army
- Numbers 1:45.** And all those registered of the sons of Israel according to the house of their fathers from twenty years old upward everyone going out to the army in Israel came to be

Numbers 4:3. **from thirty years old upward to fifty years old all those going into the service group to do the work in the tent of meeting**

Numbers 4:23. **From thirty years old upward to fifty years you will register them all who come to enter into the service group to render service in the tent of meeting**

Numbers 4:30. **From thirty years old upward to fifty years you will register them all who enter into the service group to render the service of the tent of meeting**

Numbers 4:35. **from thirty years old upward to fifty years all who entered into the service group for the service in the tent of meeting**

Numbers 4:39. **from thirty years old upward to fifty years all who entered into the service group for the service in the tent of meeting**

Numbers 4:43. **from thirty years old upward to fifty years old all those entering into the service group for the service in the tent of meeting**

Numbers 4:47. **from thirty years old upward to fifty years old all those coming to render the laborious service and the service of carrying loads in the tent of meeting**

Numbers 8:24. **This is what applies to the Levites From twenty-five years old upward he will come to enter into the company in the service of the tent of meeting**

Numbers 8:25. **But after the age of fifty years he will retire from the service company and serve no longer**

Numbers 13:22. **When they went up into the Negeb they then came to Hebron Now Ahiman Sheshai and Talmai those born of Anak were there Incidentally Hebron had been built seven years before Zoan of Egypt**

Numbers 14:29. **In this wilderness YOUR carcasses will fall yes all YOUR registered ones of all YOUR number from twenty years old upward YOU who have murmured against me**

Numbers 14:33. **And YOUR sons will become shepherds in the wilderness forty years and they will have to answer for YOUR acts of fornication until YOUR carcasses come to their end in the wilderness**

Numbers 14:34. **By the number of the days that YOU spied out the land forty days a day for a year a day for a year YOU will answer for YOUR errors forty years as YOU must know what my being estranged means**

Numbers 26:2. **TAKE the sum of the whole assembly of the sons of Israel from twenty years of age and upward according to the house of their fathers all those going out to the army in Israel**

Numbers 26:4. **Take the sum of them from the age of twenty years and upward just as Yehowah had commanded Moses Now the sons of Israel who went out of the land of Egypt were**

Numbers 32:11. **The men who came up out of Egypt from twenty years old upward will not see the soil of which I have sworn to Abraham Isaac and Jacob because they have not followed me wholly**

Numbers 32:13. **So Yehowah's anger blazed against Israel and he made them wander about in the wilderness forty years until all the generation that was doing evil in the eyes of Yehowah came to their end**

Numbers 33:39. **And Aaron was a hundred and twenty-three years old at his death on Mount Hor**

Deuteronomy 2:7.. **For Yehowah your God has blessed you in every deed of your hand He well knows of your walking through this great wilderness These forty years Yehowah your God has been with you You have not lacked a thing**



Deuteronomy 2:14, **And the days that we walked from Kadesh-barnea until we crossed the torrent valley of Zered were thirty-eight years until all the generation of the men of war had come to their end from the midst of the camp just as Yehowah had sworn to them**

Deuteronomy 8:2, **And you must remember all the way that Yehowah your God made you walk these forty years in the wilderness in order to humble you to put you to the test so as to know what was in your heart as to whether you would keep his commandments or not**

Deuteronomy 8:4, **Your mantle did not wear out upon you nor did your foot become swollen these forty years**

Deuteronomy 14:28, **At the end of three years you will bring out the entire tenth part of your produce in that year and you must deposit it inside your gates**

Deuteronomy 15:1, **At the end of every seven years you should make a release**

Deuteronomy 15:12, **In case there should be sold to you your brother a Hebrew or a Hebrewess and he has served you six years then in the seventh year you should send him out from you as one set free**

Deuteronomy 15:18, **It should not be something hard in your eyes when you send him out from your company as one set free because for double the value of a hired laborer he served you six years and Yehowah your God has blessed you in everything that you would do**

Deuteronomy 29:5, **'While I kept guiding YOU forty years in the wilderness YOUR garments did not wear out upon YOU and your sandal did not wear out upon your foot**

Deuteronomy 31:2,       **and said to them A hundred and twenty years old I am today I shall no more be allowed to go out and come in as Yehowah has said to me You will not cross this Jordan**

Deuteronomy 31:10,       **And Moses went on to command them saying At the end of every seven years in the appointed time of the year of the release in the festival of booths**

Deuteronomy 32:7,       **Remember the days of old CONSIDER the years back from generation to generation Ask your father and he can tell you Your old men and they can say it to you**

Deuteronomy 34:7,       **And Moses was a hundred and twenty years old at his death His eye had not grown dim and his vital strength had not fled**

Joshua 5:6,       **For the sons of Israel had walked forty years in the wilderness until all the nation of the men of war who came out of Egypt that did not listen to the voice of Yehowah had come to its finish to whom Yehowah swore that he would never let them see the land that Yehowah had sworn to their forefathers to give to us a land flowing with milk and honey**

Joshua 13:1,       **Now Joshua was old being advanced in years So Yehowah said to him You yourself have grown old and have advanced in years and to a very great extent the land yet remains to be taken in possession**

Joshua 14:7,       **Forty years old I was when Moses the servant of Yehowah sent me out of Kadesh-barnea to spy out the land and I came bringing him back word just as it was in my heart**

Joshua 14:10,       **And now here Yehowah has preserved me alive just as he promised these forty-five years since Yehowah made this promise to Moses when Israel walked in the wilderness and now here I am today eighty-five years old**

- Joshua 24:29. **And it came about that after these things Joshua the son of Nun the servant of Yehowah gradually died at the age of a hundred and ten years**
- Judges 2:8.. **Then Joshua the son of Nun the servant of Yehowah died at the age of a hundred and ten years**
- Judges 3:8. **Timothy At this Yehowah's anger blazed against Israel so that he sold them into the hand of Cushan-rishathaim the king of Mesopotamia and the sons of Israel continued to serve Cushan-rishathaim eight years**
- Judges 3:11. **After that the land had no disturbance for forty years Eventually Othniel the son of Kenaz died**
- Judges 3:14. **And the sons of Israel continued to serve Eglon the king of Moab eighteen years**
- Judges 3:30. **And Moab came to be subdued on that day under Israel's hand and the land had no further disturbance for eighty years**
- Judges 4:3. **And the sons of Israel began to cry out to Yehowah because he had nine hundred war chariots with iron scythes and he himself oppressed the sons of Israel with harshness twenty years**
- Judges 5:31. **Thus let all your enemies perish O Yehowah and let your lovers be as when the sun goes forth in its mightiness And the land had no further disturbance for forty years**
- Judges 6:1. **Then the sons of Israel began to do what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah So Yehowah gave them into the hand of Midian for seven years**
- Judges 6:25. **And it came about during that night that Yehowah went on to say to him Take the young bull the bull that belongs to your father that is the second young bull of seven years and you must**

**tear down the altar of Baal that is your father's and the sacred pole that is by it you should cut down**

**Judges 8:28. Thus Midian was subdued before the sons of Israel and they did not lift up their head anymore and the land had no further disturbance for forty years in the days of Gideon**

**Judges 9:22. And Abimelech kept playing the prince over Israel three years**

**Judges 10:2. And he continued to judge Israel for twenty-three years after which he died and was buried in Shamir**

**Judges 10:3. Then after him Jair the Gileadite rose up and he continued to judge Israel for twenty-two years**

**Judges 10:8. Hence they shattered and heavily oppressed the sons of Israel in that year for eighteen years all the sons of Israel that were on the side of the Jordan in the land of the Amorites that was in Gilead**

**Judges 11:26. While Israel was dwelling in Heshbon and its dependent towns and in Aroer and its dependent towns and in all the cities that are by the banks of Arnon for three hundred years why then did you never snatch them away during that time**

**Judges 12:7. And Jephthah continued to judge Israel for six years after which Jephthah the Gileadite died and was buried in his city in Gilead**

**Judges 12:9. And he came to have thirty sons and thirty daughters He sent outside and brought in thirty daughters for his sons from outside And he continued to judge Israel for seven years**

**Judges 12:11. And after him Elon the Zebulunite began to judge Israel And he continued to judge Israel ten years**

Judges 12:14. **And he came to have forty sons and thirty grandsons who rode on seventy full-grown asses And he continued to judge Israel eight years**

Judges 13:1. **And the sons of Israel engaged again in doing what was bad in Yehowah's eyes so that Yehowah gave them into the hand of the Philistines for forty years**

Judges 15:20. **And he continued to judge Israel in the days of the Philistines twenty years**

Judges 16:31. **Later his brothers and all the household of his father came on down and lifted him up and brought him up and buried him between Zorah and Eshtaol in the burial place of Manoah his father As for him he had judged Israel twenty years**

Ruth 1:4.. **Later the men took wives for themselves Moabite women The name of the one was Orpah and the name of the other Ruth And they went on dwelling there for about ten years**

1 Samuel 4:15.. **Now Eli was ninety-eight years old and his eyes had set so that he was unable to see**

1 Samuel 4:18. **And it came about that at the moment that he mentioned the ark of the true God he began to fall from the seat backward beside the gate and his neck got broken so that he died because the man was old and heavy and he himself had judged Israel forty years**

1 Samuel 7:2. **And it came about that from the day of the Ark's dwelling in Kiriath-jearim the days kept multiplying so that they amounted to twenty years and all the house of Israel went lamenting after Yehowah**

1 Samuel 13:1. **Saul was years old when he began to reign and for two years he reigned over Israel**

- 2 Samuel 2:10.. Forty years old Ish-bosheth** Saul's son was when he became king over Israel and for two years he ruled as king Only the house of Judah proved themselves followers of David
- 2 Samuel 2:11.** And the number of the days that David proved to be king in Hebron over the house of Judah **came to be seven years and six months**
- 2 Samuel 4:4.** Now Jonathan the son of Saul had a son lame **in the feet** **Five years old he happened to** be when the report about Saul and Jonathan came from Jezreel and his nurse began to carry him and flee but it came about that as she was running in panic to flee he then had a fall and was lamed And his name was Mephibosheth
- 2 Samuel 5:4.** **Thirty years old was David when** he became king For forty years he ruled as king
- 2 Samuel 5:5.** In Hebron he ruled as king **over Judah for seven years and six months and** in Jerusalem he ruled as king for thirty-three years over all Israel and Judah
- 2 Samuel 13:23.** And it turned **out after two full years that Absalom came to** have sheepshearers at Baal-hazor which is close by Ephraim and Absalom proceeded to invite all the sons of the king
- 2 Samuel 13:38.** As for Absalom he ran off and made his way to Geshur and he came **to be there three years**
- 2 Samuel 14:28.** And Absalom continued dwelling in **Jerusalem for two full years and the face of the king** he did not see
- 2 Samuel 15:7.** And it came about at **the end of forty years that Absalom proceeded to say to the king** Let me go please and pay in Hebron my vow that I solemnly made to Yehowah

- 2 Samuel 19:32, **And Barzillai was very old being eighty years of age and he himself supplied the king with food while he was dwelling in Mahanaim for he was a very great man**
- 2 Samuel 19:34, **But Barzillai said to the king What are the days of the years of my life like that I should go up with the king to Jerusalem**
- 2 Samuel 19:35, **I am eighty years old today Could I discern between good and bad or could your servant taste what I ate and what I drank or could I listen anymore to the voice of male and female singers So why should your servant become a burden anymore to my lord the king**
- 2 Samuel 21:1, **Now there came to be a famine in the days of David for three years year after year and David proceeded to consult the face of Yehowah Then Yehowah said Upon Saul and upon his house there is bloodguilt because he put the Gibeonites to death**

- 1 Kings 6:38, **and in the eleventh year in the lunar month of Bul that is the eighth month the house was finished as regards all its details and all its plan so that he was seven years at building it**

- 1 Kings 7:1. **And his own house Solomon built in thirteen years so that he finished all his own house**
- 1 Kings 9:10. **And it came about at the end of twenty years in which Solomon built the two houses the house of Yehowah and the house of the king**
- 1 Kings 10:22. **For the king had a fleet of ships of Tarshish on the sea along with Hiram's fleet of ships Once every three years the fleet of ships of Tarshish would come carrying gold and silver ivory and apes and peacocks**
- 1 Kings 11:42. **And the days that Solomon had reigned in Jerusalem over all Israel were forty years**
- 1 Kings 14:20. **And the days that Jeroboam reigned were twenty-two years after which he lay down with his forefathers and Nadab his son began to reign in place of him**
- 1 Kings 14:21. **As for Rehoboam the son of Solomon he had become king in Judah Forty-one years old Rehoboam was when he began to reign and seventeen years he reigned in Jerusalem the city that Yehowah had chosen out of all the tribes of Israel to put his name there And his mother's name was Naamah the Ammonitess**
- 1 Kings 15:2. **Three years he reigned in Jerusalem and his mother's name was Maacah the granddaughter of Abishalom**
- 1 Kings 15:10. **And forty-one years he reigned in Jerusalem and his grandmother's name was Maacah the granddaughter of Abishalom**
- 1 Kings 15:25. **As for Nadab the son of Jeroboam he became king over Israel in the second year of Asa the king of Judah and he continued to reign over Israel two years**



- 1 Kings 15:33.** In the third year of Asa the king of Judah Baasha the son of Ahijah became king over all Israel in Tirzah **for twenty-four years**
- 1 Kings 16:8.** In the twenty-sixth year of Asa the king of Judah Elah the son of Baasha became king over Israel **in Tirzah for two years**
- 1 Kings 16:23.** In the thirty-first year of Asa the king of Judah Omri became king **over Israel for twelve years** **In Tirzah he reigned six years**
- 1 Kings 16:29.** And as for Ahab the son of Omri he became king over Israel in the thirty-eighth year of Asa the king of Judah and Ahab the son of Omri continued to reign over Israel in **Samaria twenty-two years**

- 1 Kings 22:42.** Jehoshaphat **was thirty-five years old when he began to reign** and for twenty-five years he reigned in Jerusalem and his mother's name was Azubah the daughter of Shilhi
- 1 Kings 22:51.** As for Ahaziah the son of Ahab he became king over Israel in Samaria in the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah and he continued to reign **over Israel for two years**
- 2 Kings 3:1.** As for Jehoram the son of Ahab he became king over Israel in Samaria in the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah and he continued **to reign for twelve years**

2 Kings 12:1. **In the seventh year of Jehu Jehoash became king and for forty years he reigned in Jerusalem And his mother's name was Zibiah from Beer-sheba**

2 Kings 13:1. **In the twenty-third year of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah the king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu became king over Israel in Samaria for seventeen years**

- 2 Kings 13:10. **In the thirty-seventh year of Jehoash the king of Judah Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz became king over Israel in Samaria for sixteen years**
- 2 Kings 14:2. **Twenty-five years old he happened to be when he began to reign and for twenty-nine years he reigned in Jerusalem And his mother's name was Jehoaddin of Jerusalem**

1 Chronicles 27:23, **And David did not take the number of those from twenty years of age and under because Yehowah had promised to make Israel as many as the stars of the heavens**

2 Chronicles 8:1, **And it came about at the end of twenty years in which Solomon had built the house of Yehowah and his own house**

2 Chronicles 26:3, **Sixteen years old was Uzziah when he began to reign and for fifty-two years he reigned in Jerusalem And his mother's name was Jecoliah of Jerusalem**

2 Chronicles 27:1, **Twenty-five years old was Jotham when he began to reign and for sixteen years he reigned in Jerusalem And his mother's name was Jerushah the daughter of Zadok**

2 Chronicles 27:8, **Twenty-five years old he happened to be when he began to reign and for sixteen years he reigned in Jerusalem**

2 Chronicles 28:1, **Twenty years old was Ahaz when he began to reign and for sixteen years he reigned in Jerusalem and he did not do what was right in Yehowah's eyes like David his forefather**

2 Chronicles 29:1, **Hezekiah himself became king at the age of twenty-five years and for twenty-nine years he reigned in Jerusalem And his mother's name was Abijah the daughter of Zechariah**

**Nehemiah 9:30.** But you were indulgent **with them for many years and kept bearing witness** against them by your spirit by means of your prophets and they did not give ear Finally you gave them into the hand of the peoples of the lands

**Job 10:5..** Are your days like the days of **mortal man or your years just like the days** of an able-bodied man

**Job 15:20.** All his days a wicked one is suffering torture even **the very number of years that have been reserved** for the tyrant

**Proverbs 5:9.** that you may not give to others your dignity nor your years to what is cruel

**Proverbs 9:11.** For by me your days will become many and to you years of life will be added

**Proverbs 10:27.** The very fear of Yehowah will add days but the years themselves of the wicked ones will be cut short

**Ecclesiastes 6:3..** If a man should become a father a hundred times and he should live many years so that numerous the days of his years should become yet his own soul is not satisfied with good things and even the grave has not become his I must say that one prematurely born is better off than he is

**Ecclesiastes 6:6.** Even supposing that he has lived a thousand years twice over and yet he has not seen what is good is it not to just one place that everyone is going

**Ecclesiastes 11:8.** for if a man should live even many years in all of them let him rejoice And let him remember the days of darkness though they could be many every day that has come in is vanity

**Ecclesiastes 12:1.** Remember now your Grand Creator in the days of your young manhood before the calamitous days proceed to come or the years have arrived when you will say I have no delight in them

**Isaiah 7:8..** For the head of Syria is Damascus and the head of Damascus is Rezin and within **just sixty-five years** Ephraim will be **shattered** to pieces so as not to be a people

**Isaiah 16:14.** And now Yehowah has **spoken saying** **Within three years** according to the years of a hired laborer the glory of Moab must also be disgraced with much commotion of every sort and those who remain over will be a trifling few not mighty

**Isaiah 20:3.** And Yehowah went on to say Just as my servant Isaiah has walked about **naked and barefoot three years** as a sign and a portent against Egypt and against Ethiopia

**Isaiah 21:16.** For this is what Yehowah has said to me Within yet a **year** according to the **years** of a hired laborer all the glory of Kedar must even come to its end

**Isaiah 23:15.** And it must occur in that day that Tyre **must be forgotten seventy years** the same as the days of one king At the end of seventy years it will happen to Tyre as in the song of a prostitute

**Isaiah 23:17.** And it must occur at **the end of seventy years** that **Yehowah will turn** his attention to Tyre and she must return to her hire and commit prostitution with all the kingdoms of the earth upon the surface of the ground

**Isaiah 38:5.** Go and you must say to Hezekiah This is what Yehowah the God of David your forefather has said I have heard your prayer I have seen your tears Here I am adding **onto your days fifteen years**

**Isaiah 38:10.** I myself said In the midst of my days I will go into the gates of Sheol I must be deprived of **the remainder of my years**

**Isaiah 38:15.** What shall I speak and what will he actually say to me He himself has also acted I keep **walking solemnly all my years** in **the bitterness** of my soul

Isaiah 65:20. **No more will there come to be a suckling a few days old from that place neither an old man that does not fulfill his days for one will die as a mere boy although a hundred years of age and as for the sinner although a hundred years of age he will have evil called down upon him**

Jeremiah 25:3. **From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon the king of Judah and down to this day these twenty-three years the word of Yehowah has occurred to me and I kept speaking to YOU people rising up early and speaking but YOU did not listen**

Jeremiah 25:11. **And all this land must become a devastated place an object of astonishment and these nations will have to serve the king of Babylon seventy years**

Jeremiah 25:12. **And it must occur that when seventy years have been fulfilled I shall call to account against the king of Babylon and against that nation' is the utterance of Yehowah their error even against the land of the Chaldeans and I will make it desolate wastes to time indefinite**

Jeremiah 28:3. **Within two full years more I am bringing back to this place all the utensils of the house of Yehowah that Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon took from this place that he might bring them to Babylon**

Jeremiah 28:11. **And Hananiah went on to say before the eyes of all the people This is what Yehowah has said Just like this I shall break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon within two full years more from off the neck of all the nations And Jeremiah the prophet proceeded to go his way**

Jeremiah 29:10. **For this is what Yehowah has said In accord with the fulfilling of seventy years at Babylon I shall turn my attention to YOU people and I will establish toward YOU my good word in bringing YOU back to this place**

Jeremiah 34:14. **At the end of seven years YOU men should let go each one his brother a Hebrew man who came to be sold to you and who has served you six years and you must let him go free from being with you But YOUR forefathers did not listen to me neither did they incline their ear**

Jeremiah 52:1. **Zedekiah was twenty-one years old when he began to reign and for eleven years he reigned in Jerusalem And the name of his mother was Hamutal the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah**

Ezekiel 4:5. **And I myself must give to you the years of their error to the number of three hundred and ninety days and you must carry the error of the house of Israel**

Ezekiel 22:4. **by your blood that you have shed you have become guilty and by your dungy idols that you have made you have become unclean And you bring your days near and you will come to your years That is why I must make you an object of reproach to the nations and of jeering to all the lands**

Ezekiel 29:11. **There will not pass through it the foot of earthling man nor will the foot of domestic animal pass through it and for forty years it will not be inhabited**

Ezekiel 29:12. **And I will make the land of Egypt a desolate waste in the midst of desolated lands and its own cities will become a desolate waste in the very midst of devastated cities for forty years and I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations and disperse them among the lands**

Ezekiel 29:13. **For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said At the end of forty years I shall collect the Egyptians together out of the peoples among whom they will have been scattered**

Ezekiel 38:8. **After many days you will be given attention In the final part of the years you will come to the land of people brought back from the sword collected together out of many peoples onto the mountains of Israel that have proved to be a constantly**



**devastated place even a land that has been brought forth from the peoples where they have dwelt in security all of them**

**Ezekiel 38:17.** This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said Are you the same one of whom I spoke in the former days by the hand of my servants the prophets of Israel who were **prophesying in those days years as to bringing you** in upon them

**Ezekiel 39:9.** And the inhabitants of the cities of Israel will certainly go forth and burn and build fires with the armor and bucklers and large shields with the bows and with the arrows and with the handstaves and with the lances and with them they will have **to light fires seven years**

**Daniel 1:5..** Furthermore to them the king appointed a daily allowance from the delicacies of the king and from his drinking wine even **to nourish them for three years that at the end** of these they might stand before the king

**Daniel 5:31.** and Darius the Mede himself received the kingdom being **about sixty-two years old**

**Daniel 9:2.** in the first year of his reigning I myself Daniel discerned by the books **the number of the years concerning which the word** of Yehowah had occurred to Jeremiah the prophet for fulfilling the devastations of Jerusalem namely seventy years

**Daniel 11:6.** And at **the end of some years they will ally themselves** with each other and the very daughter of the king of the south will come to the king of the north in order to make an equitable arrangement But she will not retain the power of her arm and he will not stand neither his arm and she will be given up she herself and those bringing her in and he who caused her birth and the one making her strong in those times

**Daniel 11:8.** And also with their gods with their molten images with **their desirable articles of silver and of gold and with the captives**

he will come to Egypt And he **himself will for some years stand off from the king of the north**

Daniel 11:13. And the king of the north must return and set up a crowd larger than the first and at the end **of the times some years he will come doing** so with a great military force and with a great deal of goods

Joel 2:2.. It is a day of darkness and gloominess a day of clouds and thick gloom like light of dawn spread out upon the mountains There is a people numerous and mighty one like it has not been made to exist from the indefinite past and after it there will be **none again to the years of generation after generation**

Joel 2:25. And I will make compensation **to YOU for the years that the locust the** creeping unwinged locust and the cockroach and the caterpillar have eaten my great military force that I have sent among YOU

Amos 1:1.. The words of Amos who happened to be among the sheep raisers from Tekoa which he visioned concerning Israel in the days of Uzziah the king of Judah and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash the **king of Israel two years before the earthquake**

Amos 2:10. And I myself brought YOU people up out of the land of Egypt and I kept making YOU walk **through the wilderness forty years in order to take** possession of the land of the Amorite

Amos 5:25. Was it sacrifices and gift offerings that YOU people brought near to me in **the wilderness for forty years O house of Israel**

Habakkuk 3:2.. O Yehowah I have heard the report about you I have become afraid O Yehowah of your activity In **the midst of the years O bring it to life** In the midst of the years may you make it known During the agitation to show mercy may you remember

**Zechariah 1:12..** So the angel of Yehowah answered and said O Yehowah of armies how long will you yourself not show mercy to Jerusalem and to the cities of Judah whom you **have denounced these seventy years**

**Zechariah 7:3.** saying to the priests who belonged to the house of Yehowah of armies and to the prophets even saying Shall I weep in the fifth month practicing an abstinence the way I have done **these O how many years**

**Zechariah 7:5.** Say to all the people of the land and to the priests When YOU fasted and there was a wailing in the fifth month and in the seventh month **and this for seventy years did YOU really fast to me even me**

**Malachi 3:4..** And the gift offering of Judah and of Jerusalem will actually be gratifying to Yehowah as in the days of long ago **and as in the years of antiquity**

**Matthew 2:16..** Then Herod seeing he had been outwitted by the astrologers fell into a great rage and he sent out and had all the boys in Bethlehem and in all its districts done **away with from two years of age and under** according to the time that he had carefully ascertained from the astrologers

**Matthew 9:20.** And look **a woman suffering twelve years from a flow of blood** came up behind and touched the fringe of his outer garment

**Mark 5:25..** Now there was a woman subject to a **flow of blood twelve years**

**Mark 5:42.** And immediately the maiden rose and began walking **for she was twelve years old And at once they were beside themselves with great ecstasy**

**Luke 1:7..** But they had no child because Elizabeth was barren and they both **were well along in years**

- Luke 1:18,       **And Zechariah said to the angel How am I to be sure of this For I am aged and my wife is well along in years**
- Luke 2:36,       **Now there was Anna a prophetess Phanael's daughter of Asher's tribe this woman was well along in years and had lived with a husband for seven years from her virginity**
- Luke 2:37,       **and she was a widow now eighty-four years old who was never missing from the temple rendering sacred service night and day with fastings and supplications**
- Luke 2:42,       **And when he became twelve years old they went up according to the custom of the festival**
- Luke 3:23,       **Furthermore Jesus himself when he commenced his work was about thirty years old being the son as the opinion was of Joseph son of Heli**
- Luke 4:25,       **For instance I tell YOU in truth There were many widows in Israel in the days of Elijah when the heaven was shut up three years and six months so that a great famine fell upon all the land**
- Luke 8:42,       **because he had an only-begotten daughter about twelve years old and she was dying As he was going the crowds thronged him**
- Luke 8:43,       **And a woman subject to a flow of blood for twelve years who had not been able to get a cure from anyone**
- Luke 12:19,      **and I will say to my soul Soul you have many good things laid up for many years take your ease eat drink enjoy yourself**
- Luke 13:7,       **Then he said to the vinedresser Here it is three years that I have come looking for fruit on this fig tree but have found none Cut it down Why really should it keep the ground useless**

- Luke 13:11,      **And look a woman with a spirit of weakness for eighteen years and she was bent double and was unable to raise herself up at all**
- Luke 13:16,      **Was it not due then for this woman who is a daughter of Abraham and whom Satan held bound look eighteen years to be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day**
- Luke 15:29,      **In reply he said to his father Here it is so many years I have slaved for you and never once did I transgress your commandment and yet to me you never once gave a kid for me to enjoy myself with my friends**
- John 2:20,,      **Therefore the Jews said This temple was built in forty-six years and will you raise it up in three days**
- John 5:5,      **But a certain man was there who had been in his sickness for thirty-eight years**
- John 8:57,      **Therefore the Jews said to him You are not yet fifty years old and still you have seen Abraham**
- Acts of Apostles 4:22,,      **for the man upon whom this sign of healing had occurred was more than forty years old**
- Acts of Apostles 7:6,      **Moreover God spoke to this effect that his seed would be alien residents in a foreign land and the people would enslave them and afflict them for four hundred years**
- Acts of Apostles 7:30,      **And when forty years were fulfilled there appeared to him in the wilderness of Mount Sinai an angel in the fiery flame of a thornbush**
- Acts of Apostles 7:36,      **This man led them out after doing portents and signs in Egypt and in the Red Sea and in the wilderness for forty years**

Acts of Apostles 7:42. **So God turned and handed them over to render sacred service to the army of heaven just as it is written in the book of the prophets It was not to me that YOU offered victims and sacrifices for forty years in the wilderness was it O house of Israel**

Acts of Apostles 9:33. **There he found a certain man named Aeneas who had been lying flat on his cot for eight years as he was paralyzed**

Acts of Apostles 13:18. **And for a period of about forty years he put up with their manner of action in the wilderness**

Acts of Apostles 13:20. **all that during about four hundred and fifty years And after these things he gave them judges until Samuel the prophet**

Acts of Apostles 13:21. **But from then on they demanded a king and God gave them Saul son of Kish a man of the tribe of Benjamin for forty years**

Acts of Apostles 19:10. **This took place for two years so that all those inhabiting the district of Asia heard the word of the Lord both Jews and Greeks**

Acts of Apostles 20:31. **Therefore keep awake and bear in mind that for three years night and day I did not quit admonishing each one with tears**

Acts of Apostles 24:10. **And Paul when the governor nodded to him to speak answered Knowing well that this nation has had you as judge for many years I readily speak in my defense the things about myself**

Acts of Apostles 24:17. **So after quite a number of years I arrived to bring gifts of mercy to my nation and offerings**

Acts of Apostles 24:27. **But when two years had elapsed Felix was succeeded by Porcius Festus and because Felix desired to gain favor with the Jews he left Paul bound**

Acts of Apostles 28:30. **So he remained for an entire two years in his own hired house and he would kindly receive all those who came in to him**

Romans 4:19.. **And although he did not grow weak in faith he considered his own body now already deadened as he was about one hundred years old also the deadness of the womb of Sarah**

Romans 15:23. **But now that I no longer have untouched territory in these regions and for some years having had a longing to get to YOU**

2 Corinthians 12:2.. **I know a man in union with Christ who fourteen years ago whether in the body I do not know or out of the body I do not know God knows was caught away as such to the third heaven**

Galatians 1:18.. **Then three years later I went up to Jerusalem to visit Cephas and I stayed with him for fifteen days**

Galatians 2:1. **Then after fourteen years I again went up to Jerusalem with Barnabas taking also Titus along with me**

Galatians 3:17. **Further I say this As to the covenant previously validated by God the Law that has come into being four hundred and thirty years later does not invalidate it so as to abolish the promise**

Galatians 4:10. **YOU are scrupulously observing days and months and seasons and years**

1 Timothy 5:9.. **Let a widow be put on the list who has become not less than sixty years old a wife of one husband**

Hebrews 1:12.. **and you will wrap them up just as a cloak as an outer garment and they will be changed but you are the same and your years will never run out**

Hebrews 3:9. **in which YOUR forefathers made a test of me with a trial and yet they had seen my works for forty years**

Hebrews 3:17. **Moreover with whom did God become disgusted for forty years Was it not with those who sinned whose carcasses fell in the wilderness**

James 5:17.. **Elijah was a man with feelings like ours and yet in prayer he prayed for it not to rain and it did not rain upon the land for three years and six months**

2 Peter 3:8.. **However let this one fact not be escaping YOUR notice beloved ones that one day is with Yehowah as a thousand years and a thousand years as one day**

Revelation 20:2.. **And he seized the dragon the original serpent who is the Devil and Satan and bound him for a thousand years**

Revelation 20:3. **And he hurled him into the abyss and shut it and sealed it over him that he might not mislead the nations anymore until the thousand years were ended After these things he must be let loose for a little while**

Revelation 20:4. **And I saw thrones and there were those who sat down on them and power of judging was given them Yes I saw the souls of those executed with the ax for the witness they bore to Jesus and for speaking about God and those who had worshiped neither the wild beast nor its image and who had not received the Mark upon their forehead and upon their hand And they came to life and ruled as kings with the Christ for a thousand years**

Revelation 20:5. **The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended This is the first resurrection**

Revelation 20:6. **Happy and holy is anyone having part in the first resurrection over these the second death has no authority but they will be priests of God and of the Christ and will rule as kings with him for the thousand years**



Revelation 20:7. **Now as soon as the thousand years have been ended Satan will be let loose out of his prison**
