**Genesis 4:23..** Consequently Lamech composed these words for his wives Adah and Zillah Hear my voice you wives of Lamech Give ear to my saying A man I have killed for **wounding me yes a young man for giving me** a blow

**Genesis 14:24.** Nothing for **me Only what the young men have already eaten** and the share of the men who went with me Aner Eshcol and Mamre let them take their share

**Genesis 15:9.** In turn he said to him Take for me a three year old heifer and a three year old she-goat and a three year old ram and **a turtledove and a young pigeon**

**Genesis 18:7.** Next Abraham ran to the herd and proceeded to get **a tender and good young bull and to give** it to the attendant and he went hurrying to get it ready

**Genesis 18:8.** He then took butter **and milk and the young bull that he had** got ready and set it before them Then he himself kept standing by them under the tree as they were eating

**Genesis 24:14.** What must **occur is that the young woman to whom I shall say** Let your water jar down please that I may take a drink and who will indeed say Take a drink and I shall also water your camels this is the one you must assign to your servant to Isaac and by this let me know that you have performed loyal with my master

**Genesis 24:16.** **Now the young woman was very attractive** in appearance a virgin and no man had had sexual intercourse with her and she made her way down to the fountain and began to fill her water jar and then came up

- Genesis 24:28. **And the young woman went running and telling the household of her mother about these things**
- Genesis 24:55. **To this her brother and her mother said Let the young woman stay with us at least ten days Afterward she can go**
- Genesis 24:57. **So they said Let us call the young woman and inquire at her mouth**
- Genesis 30:32. **I will pass among your whole flock today You set aside from there every sheep speckled and with color patches and every dark-brown sheep among the young rams and any color-patched and speckled one among the she-goats Hereafter such must be my wages**
- Genesis 30:33. **And my right-doing must answer for me on whatever future day you may come to look over my wages every one that is not speckled and color-patched among the she-goats and dark brown among the young rams is something stolen if it is with me**
- Genesis 30:35. **Then he set aside on that day the he-goats striped and color-patched and all the she-goats speckled and color-patched every one in which there was any white and every one dark brown among the young rams but he gave them over into the hands of his sons**
- Genesis 30:40. **And Jacob separated the young rams and then turned the faces of the flocks to the striped ones and all the dark-brown ones among the flocks of Laban Then he set his own droves by themselves and did not set them by the flocks of Laban**
- Genesis 32:15. **thirty camels giving suck and their young ones forty cows and ten bulls twenty she-asses and ten full-grown asses**
- Genesis 32:22. **Later during that night he rose and took his two wives and his two maidservants and his eleven young sons and crossed over the ford of Jabbok**

Genesis 34:3. **And his soul began clinging to Dinah the daughter of Jacob and he fell in love with the young woman and kept speaking persuasively to the young woman**

Genesis 34:4. **Finally Shechem said to Hamor his father Get me this young lady as a wife**

Genesis 34:12. **Raise very high the marriage money and gift imposed upon me and I stand willing to give according to what YOU may say to me only give me the young woman as a wife**

Genesis 34:19. **and the young man did not delay to perform the condition because he did find delight in Jacob's daughter and he was the most honorable of the whole house of his father**

Genesis 41:12. **And there was with us there a young man a Hebrew a servant of the chief of the bodyguard When we related them to him he proceeded to interpret our dreams to us He interpreted to each according to his dream**

Exodus 10:9.. **Then Moses said With our young people and our old people we shall go With our sons and our daughters with our sheep and our cattle we shall go for we have a festival to Yehowah**

Exodus 12:5. **The sheep should prove to be sound a male a year old for YOU YOU may pick from the young rams or from the goats**

Exodus 13:12. **then you must devote everyone that opens the womb to Yehowah and every firstling the young of a beast which will come to be yours The males belong to Yehowah**

Exodus 24:5. **After that he sent young men of the sons of Israel and they offered up burnt offerings and sacrificed bulls as sacrifices as communion sacrifices to Yehowah**

Exodus 29:1. **And this is the thing that you are to do to them to sanctify them for acting as priests to me Take a young bull and two rams sound ones**

Exodus 29:38. **And this is what you will offer upon the altar young rams each a year old two a day constantly**

Exodus 29:39. **And you will offer the one young ram in the morning and you will offer the other young ram between the two evenings**

Exodus 29:40. **And a tenth part of an ephah measure of fine flour moistened with the fourth of a hin of beaten oil and a drink offering of the fourth of a hin of wine will go for the first young ram**

Exodus 29:41. **And you will offer the second young ram between the two evenings With a grain offering like that of the morning and with a drink offering like its you will render it as a restful odor an offering made by fire to Yehowah**

Leviticus 1:5.. **Then the young bull must be slaughtered before Yehowah and the sons of Aaron the priests must present the blood and sprinkle the blood round about upon the altar which is at the entrance of the tent of meeting**

Leviticus 1:10. **And if his offering for a burnt offering is from the flock from the young rams or the goats a male a sound one is what he will present**

Leviticus 1:14. **However if his offering as a burnt offering to Yehowah is from the fowls then he must present his offering from the turtledoves or the young pigeons**

Leviticus 3:7. **If he is presenting a young ram as his offering then he must present it before Yehowah**

Leviticus 4:3. **If the priest the anointed one sins so as to bring guiltiness upon the people then he must present for his sin that he **has committed a sound young bull to Yehowah as a sin offering****

Leviticus 4:14. **and the sin that they have committed against it has become known then the **congregation must present a young bull for a sin offering** and must bring it before the tent of meeting**

Leviticus 4:24. **And he must lay his hand upon **the head of the young goat and slaughter it** in the place where the burnt offering is regularly slaughtered before Yehowah It is a sin offering**

Leviticus 4:35. **And he will remove all its fat the same as **the fat of the young ram of the communion** sacrifice is regularly removed and the priest must make them smoke on the altar upon Yehowah's offerings made by fire and the priest must make an atonement for him for his sin that he has committed and so it must be forgiven him**

Leviticus 5:7. **If though he cannot afford enough for a sheep then he must bring as his guilt offering for the sin that he has committed **two turtledoves or two young pigeons to Yehowah one** for a sin offering and one for a burnt offering**

Leviticus 5:11. **Now if he does not have the means for **two turtledoves or two young pigeons then he must** bring as his offering for the sin he has committed the tenth of an ephah of fine flour for a sin offering He must not put oil upon it and he must not place frankincense upon it for it is a sin offering**

Leviticus 7:23. **Speak to the sons of Israel saying **YOU** must not eat any fat of **a bull or a young ram or a goat****

Leviticus 9:2. **Then he said to Aaron **Take for yourself a young calf for a sin offering** and a ram for a burnt offering sound ones and present them before Yehowah**

- Leviticus 9:3. **But to the sons of Israel you will speak saying Take a male goat for a sin offering and a calf and a young ram each a year old sound ones for a burnt offering**
- Leviticus 12:6. **Then at the fulfilling of the days of her purification for a son or for a daughter she will bring a young ram in its first year for a burnt offering and a young pigeon or a turtledove for a sin offering to the entrance of the tent of meeting to the priest**
- Leviticus 12:8. **But if she cannot afford enough for a sheep she must then take two turtledoves or two young pigeons one for a burnt offering and one for a sin offering and the priest must make atonement for her and she must be clean**
- Leviticus 14:10. **And on the eighth day he will take two sound young rams and one sound female lamb in its first year and three tenths of an ephah of fine flour as a grain offering moistened with oil and one log measure of oil**
- Leviticus 14:12. **And the priest must take the one young ram and offer it for a guilt offering together with the log measure of oil and must wave them to and fro as a wave offering before Yehowah**
- Leviticus 14:13. **And he must slaughter the young ram in the place where the sin offering and the burnt offering are regularly slaughtered in a holy place because like the sin offering the guilt offering belongs to the priest It is something most holy**
- Leviticus 14:21. **However if he is lowly and does not have enough means he must then take one young ram as a guilt offering for a wave offering in order to make atonement for him and one tenth of an ephah of fine flour moistened with oil as a grain offering and a log measure of oil**
- Leviticus 14:22. **and two turtledoves or two young pigeons according as he may have the means and the one must serve as a sin offering and the other as a burnt offering**

- Leviticus 14:24. **And the priest must take the young ram of the guilt offering and the log measure of oil and the priest must wave them to and fro as a wave offering before Yehowah**
- Leviticus 14:25. **And he must slaughter the young ram of the guilt offering and the priest must take some of the blood of the guilt offering and put it upon the lobe of the right ear of the one cleansing himself and upon the thumb of his right hand and upon the big toe of his right foot**
- Leviticus 14:30. **And he must render up the one of the turtledoves or of the young pigeons for which he may have the means**
- Leviticus 15:14. **And on the eighth day he should take for himself two turtledoves or two young pigeons and he must come before Yehowah to the entrance of the tent of meeting and give them to the priest**
- Leviticus 15:29. **And on the eighth day she should take for herself two turtledoves or two young pigeons and she must bring them to the priest at the entrance of the tent of meeting**
- Leviticus 16:3. **With the following Aaron should come into the holy place with a young bull for a sin offering and a ram for a burnt offering**
- Leviticus 17:3. **As for any man of the house of Israel who slaughters a bull or a young ram or a goat in the camp or who slaughters it outside the camp**
- Leviticus 22:19. **to gain approval for YOU it must be sound a male among the herd among the young rams or among the goats**
- Leviticus 22:27. **Should a bull or a young ram or a goat be born then it must continue under its mother seven days but from the eighth day and forward it will be accepted with approval as an offering an offering made by fire to Yehowah**

Leviticus 22:28. **As for a bull and a sheep YOU must not slaughter it and its young one on the one day**

Leviticus 23:12. **And on the day of YOUR having the sheaf waved to and fro YOU must render up a sound young ram in its first year for a burnt offering to Yehowah**

Leviticus 23:18. **And YOU must present along with the loaves seven sound male lambs each a year old and one young bull and two rams They should serve as a burnt offering to Yehowah along with their grain offering and their drink offerings as an offering made by fire of a restful odor to Yehowah**

Numbers 6:10.. **And on the eighth day he should bring two turtledoves or two young pigeons to the priest to the entrance of the tent of meeting**

Numbers 6:12. **And he must live as a Nazirite to Yehowah for the days of his Naziriteship and he must bring a young ram in its first year as a guilt offering and the former days will go uncounted because he defiled his Naziriteship**

Numbers 6:14. **And he must present as his offering to Yehowah one sound young ram in its first year as a burnt offering and one sound female lamb in its first year as a sin offering and one sound ram as a communion sacrifice**

Numbers 7:15. **one young bull one ram one male lamb in its first year for a burnt offering**

Numbers 7:21. **one young bull one ram one male lamb in its first year for a burnt offering**

Numbers 7:27. **one young bull one ram one male lamb in its first year for a burnt offering**

Numbers 7:33. **one young bull one ram one male lamb in its first year for a burnt offering**

- Numbers 11:27. **And a young man went running and reporting to Moses and saying Eldad and Medad are acting as prophets in the camp**
- Numbers 11:28. **Then Joshua the son of Nun the minister of Moses from his young manhood on responded and said My lord Moses restrain them**
- Numbers 15:24. **it must then occur that if it has been done far from the eyes of the assembly by mistake the whole assembly must then render up one young bull as a burnt offering for a restful odor to**

**Yehowah and its grain offering and its drink offering according to the regular procedure and one kid of the goats as a sin offering**

**Numbers 28:11.** And at the commencements of YOUR months YOU people will present as a burnt offering to Yehowah two young bulls and one ram seven sound male lambs each a year old

**Numbers 28:19.** And YOU must present as an offering made by fire a burnt offering to Yehowah two young bulls and one ram and seven male lambs each a year old They should prove to be sound ones for YOU

**Numbers 28:27.** And YOU must present as a burnt offering for a restful odor to Yehowah two young bulls one ram seven male lambs each a year old

**Numbers 29:2.** And YOU must render up as a burnt offering for a restful odor to Yehowah one young bull one ram seven male lambs each a year old sound ones

**Numbers 29:8.** And YOU must present as a burnt offering to Yehowah as a restful odor one young bull one ram seven male lambs each a year old They should prove to be sound ones for YOU

**Numbers 29:13.** And YOU must present as a burnt offering an offering made by fire of a restful odor to Yehowah thirteen young bulls two rams fourteen male lambs each a year old They should prove to be sound ones

**Numbers 29:17.** And on the second day twelve young bulls two rams fourteen male lambs each a year old sound ones

**Deuteronomy 7:13..** And he will certainly love you and bless you and multiply you and bless the fruit of your belly and the fruit of your soil your grain and your new wine and your oil the young of your cows and the progeny of your flock on the soil that he swore to your forefathers to give to you

Deuteronomy 21:3,       **and it must prove to be the city nearest to the slain one And the older men of that city must take a young cow of the herd that has not been worked with that has not pulled in a yoke**

Deuteronomy 21:4,       **and the older men of that city must lead the young cow down to a torrent valley running with water in which there was customarily no tilling or sowing of seed and they must break the neck of the young cow there in the torrent valley**

Deuteronomy 21:6,       **Then all the older men of that city who are nearest to the slain one should wash their hands over the young cow the neck of which was broken in the torrent valley**

Deuteronomy 22:6,       **In case a bird's nest happens to be before you in the way in any tree or on the earth with young ones or eggs and the mother is sitting upon the young ones or the eggs you must not take the mother along with the offspring**

Deuteronomy 28:4,       **Blessed will be the fruit of your belly and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your domestic beast the young of your cattle and the progeny of your flock**

Deuteronomy 28:18,       **Cursed will be the fruit of your belly and the fruitage of your ground the young of your cattle and the progeny of your flock**

Deuteronomy 28:50,       **a nation fierce in countenance who will not be partial to an old man or show favor to a young man**

Deuteronomy 28:51,       **And they will certainly eat the fruit of your domestic animals and the fruitage of your ground until you have been annihilated and they will let no grain new wine or oil no young of your cattle or progeny of your flock remain for you until they have destroyed you**

Deuteronomy 32:25,       **Outdoors a sword will bereave them and indoors fright of both young man and virgin suckling together with gray-haired man**

**Joshua 6:21..** And they went devoting all that was in the city from **man to woman from young man to old man** and to bull and sheep and ass to destruction by the edge of the sword

**Joshua 6:23.** So the **young men who had done** the spying went in and brought out Rahab and her father and her mother and her brothers and all who belonged to her yes all her family relationship they brought out and they proceeded to set them down outside the camp of Israel

**Judges 6:25..** And it came about during that night that Yehowah went on to say **to him Take the young bull the bull that** belongs to your father that is the second young bull of seven years and you must tear down the altar of Baal that is your father's and the sacred pole that is by it you should cut down

**Judges 6:26.** And you must build an altar to Yehowah your God at the head of this stronghold with the row of stones and you **must take the second young bull and offer it** up as a burnt offering on the pieces of wood of the sacred pole that you will cut down

**Judges 6:28.** When the men of the city got up early in the morning as usual why look the altar of Baal had been pulled down and the sacred pole that was beside it had been cut **down and the second young bull had been offered** up on the altar that had been built

**Judges 8:14.** En route he captured a **young man of the men** of Succoth and made inquiries of him So he wrote out for him the names of the princes of Succoth and its older men seventy-seven men

**Judges 8:2.** Then he said to Jether his firstborn Get up **kill them And the young man did not draw** his sword because he was afraid for he was yet a young man

**Judges 14:5.** Accordingly Samson went on down with his father and his mother to Timnah When he got as far as the vineyards of Timnah **why look a maned young lion roaring upon meeting** him

- Judges 14:10. **And his father continued on his way down to the woman and Samson proceeded to hold a banquet there for that **was the way the young fellows used to do****
- Judges 14:18. **So the men of the city said to him on the seventh day before ever he could go into the interior room What is sweeter than honey and what is stronger than a lion In turn he said to them If YOU had **not plowed with my young cow YOU would not have solved my riddle****
- Judges 17:7. **Now there **happened to be a young man of Bethlehem in Judah of the family of Judah and he was a Levite And he was residing there for a time****
- Judges 17:11. **Thus the Levite took it upon himself to dwell with **the man and the young man got to be as one of his sons to him****
- Judges 17:12. **Furthermore Micah filled the hand of the Levite **with power that the young man might serve as a priest for him and might continue in the house of Micah****
- Judges 18:3. **While they were close by the house of Micah they recognized **the voice of the young man the Levite so that they turned aside there And they proceeded to say to him Who brought you here and what are you doing in this place and what interest do you have here****
- Judges 18:15. **So they turned aside there and came to **the house of the young man the Levite at the house of Micah and began to ask how he was getting along****
- Judges 19:3. **Then her husband got up and went after her to speak consolingly to her so as to bring her back and there were with him his attendant and a couple of he-asses So she had him come into her father's house When **the father of the young woman got to see him he at once rejoiced to meet him****

- Judges 19:4. **Consequently his father-in-law the young woman's father took hold of him so that he continued to dwell with him three days and they would eat and drink and he would stay overnight there**
- Judges 19:5. **And it came about on the fourth day when they got up early in the morning as usual he now rose to go but the father of the young woman said to his son-in-law Sustain your heart with a bit of bread and afterward YOU people may go**
- Judges 19:6. **So they sat down and both of them began to eat and to drink together after which the father of the young woman said to the man come on please and stay overnight and let your heart feel good**
- Judges 19:8. **When he got up early in the morning on the fifth day to go the father of the young woman then said Please take sustenance for your heart And they lingered until the fading away of the day And both of them kept eating**
- Judges 19:9. **The man now rose to go he and his concubine and his attendant but his father-in-law the young woman's father said to him Look now The day has declined toward becoming evening Please STAY overnight Here the day is settling down Stay here overnight and let your heart feel good And tomorrow YOU people must get up early for YOUR journey and you must go to your tent**
- Ruth 2:5.. **Subsequently Boaz said to the young man who was set over the harvesters To whom does this young woman belong**
- Ruth 2:6. **So the young man set over the harvesters answered and said The young woman is a Moabitess who returned with Naomi from the field of Moab**
- Ruth 2:8. **Later Boaz said to Ruth You have heard have you not my daughter Do not go away to glean in another field and you must**

**also not cross over from this place and in that way you should keep close by my young women**

Ruth 2:9. **Let your eyes be on the field that they will harvest and you must go with them Have I not commanded the young men not to touch you When you are thirsty you must also go to the vessels and drink from what the young men will draw**

Ruth 2:15. **Then she got up to glean Boaz now commanded his young men saying Let her glean also among the cut-off ears of grain and YOU must not molest her**

Ruth 2:21. **Then Ruth the Moabitess said He also said to me Close by the young people that are mine is where you should keep until they have finished the entire harvest that I have**

Ruth 2:22. **So Naomi said to Ruth her daughter-in-law It is better my daughter that you should go out with his young women that they may not annoy you in another field**

Ruth 2:23. **And she continued to keep close by the young women of Boaz to glean until the harvest of the barley and the harvest of the wheat came to an end And she kept on dwelling with her mother-in-law**

Ruth 3:2. **And now is not Boaz with whose young women you have continued our kinsman Look He is winnowing barley at the threshing floor tonight**

Ruth 3:10. **At that he said Blessed may you be of Yehowah my daughter You have expressed your loving-kindness better in the last instance than in the first instance in not going after the young fellows whether lowly or rich**

Ruth 4:12. **And may your house become like the house of Perez whom Tamar bore to Judah from the offspring that Yehowah will give you out of this young woman**

- 1 Samuel 6:7..** And now take and make a new wagon and two cows that are giving suck upon which no yoke has come up and YOU must hitch the cows to the wagon and **YOU must make their young ones go back home** from following them
- 1 Samuel 6:10.** And the men proceeded to do accordingly So they took two cows that were giving suck and hitched them to **the wagon and their young ones they shut up** at home
- 1 Samuel 9:2.** And he happened to have a son **whose name was Saul young and handsome and there** was no man of the sons of Israel that was handsomer than he from his shoulders upward he was taller than all the people
- 1 Samuel 16:2.** But Samuel said How can I go Once Saul has heard of it he will certainly kill me And Yehowah went **on to say A young cow of the herd** you should take with you and you must say To sacrifice to Yehowah is why I have come
- 1 Samuel 16:12.** Accordingly he sent and had him come Now **he was ruddy a young man with beautiful eyes** and handsome in appearance Then Yehowah said Get up anoint him for this is he
- 1 Samuel 20:35.** And it came about in the morning that Jonathan made his way out to the field of David's **appointed place and a young attendant was with him**
- 1 Samuel 21:2.** At this David said to Ahimelech the priest The king himself commanded me as to a matter and he went on to say to me Let no one know anything at all of the matter concerning which I am sending you and concerning which I have commanded you And I have made **an appointment with the young men for such and such a place**
- 1 Samuel 21:4.** But the priest answered David and said There is no ordinary bread under my hand but there is holy **bread provided that the young men have at least** kept themselves from womankind



- 1 Samuel 21:5. **So David answered the priest and said to him But womankind has been kept away from us the same as formerly when I went out and the organisms of the young men continue holy although the mission itself is ordinary And how much more so today when one becomes holy in his organism**
- 1 Samuel 25:5. **So David sent ten young men and David said to the young men Go up to Carmel and YOU must come to Nabal and ask him in my name about his welfare**
- 1 Samuel 25:8. **Ask your own young men and they will tell you that my young men may find favor in your eyes because it was upon a good day that we came Just give please whatever your hand may find to your servants and to your son David**
- 1 Samuel 25:9. **Accordingly David's young men came and spoke to Nabal in accord with all these words in the name of David and then waited**
- 1 Samuel 25:12. **Upon that David's young men turned around on their way and went back and came and reported to him in accord with all these words**
- 1 Samuel 25:14. **Meanwhile to Abigail Nabal's wife one of the young men reported saying Look David sent messengers from the wilderness to wish our master well but he screamed rebukes at them**
- 1 Samuel 25:19. **Then she said to her young men Pass on ahead of me Look I am coming after YOU But to her husband Nabal she told nothing**
- 1 Samuel 25:25. **Please do not let my lord set his heart upon this good-for-nothing man Nabal for as his name is so is he Nabal is his name and senselessness is with him As for me your slave girl I did not see my lord's young men that you had sent**

- 1 Samuel 25:27. **And now as regards this gift blessing that your maidservant has brought to my lord it must be given to the young men that are walking about in the steps of my lord**
- 1 Samuel 26:22. **Then David answered and said Here is the spear of the king and let one of the young men come on over and fetch it**
- 1 Samuel 30:17. **And David went striking them down from the morning darkness until the evening that he might devote them to destruction and not a man of them escaped except four hundred young men that rode upon camels and took to flight**
- 2 Samuel 1:5.. **Then David said to the young man that was telling him How do you really know that Saul has died and also Jonathan his son**
- 2 Samuel 1:6. **At this the young man that was telling him said I unexpectedly chanced to be on Mount Gilboa and there was Saul supporting himself upon his spear and look the charioteers and the mounted men had caught up with him**
- 2 Samuel 1:13. **David now said to the young man that was telling him Where are you from to which he said I am the son of an alien resident an Amalekite**
- 2 Samuel 1:15. **With that David called one of the young men and said Go near Smite him Accordingly he struck him down so that he died**
- 2 Samuel 2:14. **Finally Abner said to Joab Let the young men rise up please and let them put on a combat before us To this Joab said Let them rise up**
- 2 Samuel 2:21. **Then Abner said to him Veer to your right or to your left and seize one of the young men as yours and take what you strip off him as yours And Asahel did not want to turn aside from following him**

- 2 Samuel 4:12. **With that David commanded the young men and they killed them and cut off their hands and their feet and hanged them by the pool in Hebron and the head of Ish-bosheth they took and then buried in the burial place of Abner in Hebron**
- 2 Samuel 9:12. **Now Mephibosheth had a young son whose name was Mica and all those dwelling in the house of Ziba were servants to Mephibosheth**
- 2 Samuel 13:32. **However Jehonadab the son of Shimeah David's brother answered and said Do not let my lord think that it is all the young men the sons of the king that they have put to death for it is Amnon alone that has died because at the order of Absalom it has occurred as something appointed from the day that he humiliated Tamar his sister**
- 2 Samuel 13:34. **Meantime Absalom went running away Later the young man the watchman raised his eyes and saw and look there were many people coming from the road behind him by the mountainside**
- 2 Samuel 14:21. **Subsequently the king said to Joab Here now I shall certainly do this thing So go bring the young man Absalom back**
- 2 Samuel 16:2. **Then the king said to Ziba What do these things mean on your part To this Ziba said The asses are for the household of the king to ride and the bread and the load of summer fruit are for the young men to eat and the wine is for the one tired out in the wilderness to drink**
- 2 Samuel 17:18. **However a young man got to see them and told Absalom So the two of them went off speedily and came to the house of a man in Bahurim who had a well in his courtyard and they went down into it**
- 2 Samuel 18:5. **And the king went on to command Joab and Abishai and Ittai saying Deal gently for my sake with the young man**

**Absalom** And all the people themselves heard when the king commanded all the chiefs over the matter of Absalom

2 Samuel 18:12. But the man said to Joab And although I were weighing upon my palms a thousand pieces of silver I should not thrust my hand out against the king's son for in our hearing it was that the king commanded you and Abishai and Ittai saying WATCH whoever **you are over the young man over Absalom**

2 Samuel 18:29. However the king said Is it well with the **young man Absalom** To this Ahimaaz said I saw the great commotion at the time Joab sent the king's servant and your servant and I did not know what it was

2 Samuel 18:32. But the king said to the Cushite Is it well with the **young man Absalom** To this the Cushite said May the enemies of my lord the king and all those who rose up against you for evil become as the young man

2 Samuel 20:11. And a **certain one of Joab's young men stood over him** and kept saying Whoever has found delight in Joab and whoever belongs to David let him follow Joab

1 Kings 11:17.. And Hadad went running away he and some Edomite men of the servants of his father with him to come into Egypt **while Hadad was a young boy**

1 Kings 11:28. Now the man Jeroboam was a valiant mighty man When Solomon got **to see that the young man was a hard worker** he proceeded to make him overseer over all the compulsory service of the house of Joseph

1 Kings 12:8. However he left the counsel of the older men with which they had advised him and he began to **take counsel with the young men that had grown up with him** who were the ones attending upon him

- 1 Kings 12:10. **In turn the young men that had grown up with him spoke to him saying This is what you should say to this people who have spoken to you saying Your father for his part made our yoke heavy but as for you make it lighter upon us' this is what you should speak to them My little finger itself will certainly be thicker than my father's hips**
- 1 Kings 12:14. **And he went on to speak to them according to the counsel of the young men saying My father for his part made YOUR yoke heavy but I for my part shall add to YOUR yoke My father for his part chastised YOU with whips but I for my part shall chastise YOU with scourges**
- 1 Kings 18:23. **Now let them give us two young bulls and let them choose for themselves one young bull and cut it in pieces and put it upon the wood but they should not put fire to it And I myself shall dress the other young bull and I must place it upon the wood but I shall not put fire to it**
- 1 Kings 18:25. **Elijah now said to the prophets of Baal Choose for yourselves one young bull and dress it first because YOU are the majority and call upon the name of YOUR god but YOU must not put fire to it**
- 1 Kings 18:26. **Accordingly they took the young bull that he gave them Then they dressed it and they kept calling upon the name of Baal from morning till noon saying O Baal answer us But there was no voice and there was no one answering And they kept limping around the altar that they had made**
- 1 Kings 18:33. **After that he put the pieces of wood in order and cut the young bull in pieces and placed it upon the pieces of wood He now said FILL four large jars with water and pour it upon the burnt offering and upon the pieces of wood**
- 1 Kings 20:14. **Then Ahab said By whom to which he said This is what Yehowah has said By the young men of the princes of the**

**jurisdictional districts Finally he said Who will open the battle engagement to which he said You**

**1 Kings 20:15. And he proceeded to take the count of the young men of the princes of the jurisdictional districts and they came to be two hundred and thirty-two and after them he took the count of all the people all the sons of Israel seven thousand**

**1 Kings 20:17. When the young men of the princes of the jurisdictional districts came out first Ben-hadad at once sent out and they came telling him saying There are men that have come out from Samaria**

**1 Kings 20:19. And these were the ones that came out from the city the young men of the princes of the jurisdictional districts and the military forces that were behind them**

**2 Kings 5:22.. To this he said All is well My master himself has sent me saying Look Just now there have come to me two young men from the mountainous region of Ephraim from the sons of the prophets Do give them please a talent of silver and two changes of garments**

**1 Chronicles 12:28.. Also Zadok a young man mighty in valor and the house of his forefathers twenty-two chiefs**

**1 Chronicles 15:26. And it came about when the true God helped the Levites while carrying the ark of the covenant of Yehowah that they proceeded to sacrifice seven young bulls and seven rams**

**1 Chronicles 22:5. Accordingly David said Solomon my son is young and delicate and the house to be built to Yehowah is to be surpassingly magnificent for beauteous distinction to all the lands Let me then make preparation for him So David made preparation in great quantities before his death**

**1 Chronicles 29:1. David the king now said to all the congregation Solomon my son the one whom God has chosen is young and**

**delicate but the work is great for the castle is not for man but for Yehowah God**

1 Chronicles 29:21, **And they continued to sacrifice sacrifices to Yehowah and offer up burnt offerings to Yehowah on the day following that day a thousand young bulls a thousand rams a thousand male lambs and their drink offerings even sacrifices in great number for all Israel**

2 Chronicles 10:8,, **However he left the counsel of the older men with which they had advised him and he began to take counsel with the young men that had grown up with him who were the ones attending upon him**

2 Chronicles 10:10, **In turn the young men that had grown up with him spoke with him saying This is what you should say to the people who have spoken to you saying Your father for his part made our yoke heavy but as for you make it lighter upon us' this is what you should say to them My own little finger will certainly be thicker than my father's hips**

2 Chronicles 10:14, **and he went on to speak to them according to the counsel of the young men saying I shall make YOUR yoke heavier and I for my part shall add to it My father for his part chastised YOU with whips but I for my part with scourges**

2 Chronicles 13:7, **And idle men good-for-nothing fellows kept collecting themselves together by him Finally they proved superior to Rehoboam the son of Solomon when Rehoboam himself happened to be young and fainthearted and he did not hold his own against them**

2 Chronicles 13:9, **Have YOU not driven out Yehowah's priests the sons of Aaron and the Levites and do YOU not keep making priests for yourselves like the peoples of the lands As for anyone that came and filled his hand with power by means of a young bull and seven rams he became a priest of what are no gods**

2 Chronicles 36:17. **So he brought up against them the king of the Chaldeans who proceeded to kill their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary neither did he feel compassion for young man or virgin old or decrepit Everything He gave into his hand**

Ezra 6:9.. **And what is needed young bulls as well as rams and lambs for the burnt offerings to the God of heaven wheat salt wine and oil just as the priests that are in Jerusalem say let there be given them continually day by day without fail**

Nehemiah 4:16.. **yes it came about that from that day forward half of my young men were active in the work and half of them were holding the lances the shields and the bows and the coats of mail and the princes were behind the whole house of Judah**

Esther 2:2.. **Then the king's attendants his ministers said Let them seek young women virgins beautiful in appearance for the king**

Esther 2:3. **and let the king appoint commissioners in all the jurisdictional districts of his realm and let them collect together all the young women virgins beautiful in appearance at Shushan the castle at the house of the women in charge of Hegai the king's eunuch the guardian of the women and let there be a giving of their massages**

Esther 2:4. **And that young woman who seems pleasing in the king's eyes will be queen instead of Vashti And the thing was pleasing in the king's eyes and he proceeded to do that way**

Esther 2:7. **And he came to be the caretaker of Hadassah that is Esther the daughter of his father's brother for she had neither father nor mother and the young woman was pretty in form and beautiful in appearance and at the death of her father and her mother Mordecai took her as his daughter**

Esther 2:8. **And it came about that when the king's word and his law were heard and when many young women were collected**



**together** at Shushan the castle in charge of Hegai then Esther was taken to the king's house in charge of Hegai the guardian of the women

Esther 2:9. **Now the young woman was pleasing in his eyes so that she gained loving-kindness before him and he made haste to give her her massages and her appropriate food and to give her seven selected young women from the king's house and he proceeded to transfer her and her young women to the best place of the house of the women**

Esther 2:12. **And when the turn of each young woman arrived to go in to King Ahasuerus after it had happened to her according to the women's regulation for twelve months for that was the way the days of their massage procedure were gradually fulfilled six months with oil of myrrh and six months with balsam oil and with the massages of the women**

Esther 2:13. **then on these conditions the young woman herself came in to the king Everything that she would mention would be given her to come with her from the house of the women to the king's house**

Esther 3:13. **And there was a sending of the letters by means of couriers to all the king's jurisdictional districts to annihilate to kill and to destroy all the Jews young man as well as old man little ones and women on one day on the thirteenth day of the twelfth month that is the month Adar and to plunder the spoil of them**

Esther 4:4. **And Esther's young women and her eunuchs began to come in and tell her And the queen was very much pained Then she sent garments to clothe Mordecai and to remove his sackcloth off him And he did not accept them**

Esther 4:16. **Go gather all the Jews that are to be found in Shushan and fast in my behalf and neither eat nor drink for three days night and day I too with my young women I shall fast likewise**

and upon that I shall come in to the king which is not according to the law and in case I must perish I must perish

**Job 1:19,,** And look There came a great wind from the region of the wilderness and it went striking the four corners of the house so that **it fell upon the young people and they died** And I got to escape only I by myself to tell you

**Job 4:10,** There is the roaring of a lion and **the voice of a young lion but the teeth** of maned young lions do get broken down

**Job 10:16,** And if it **acts haughtily like a young lion you will hunt** for me and you will again show yourself marvelous in my case

**Job 16:11,** God **hands me over to young boys and into the hands** of wicked ones he throws me headlong

**Job 19:18,** **Also young boys themselves have rejected** me let me but rise up and they begin to speak against me

**Job 21:11,** They **keep sending out their young boys just like a flock** and their own male children go skipping about

**Job 28:8,** The majestic wild beasts have not trodden **it down solid the young lion has not paced** over it

**Job 31:20,** If his loins did not bless me nor from the **shorn wool of my young rams he would warm himself**

- Job 38:41. **Who prepares for the raven its food when its own young ones cry to God for help when they keep wandering about because there is nothing to eat**
- Job 39:3. **They bow down when they cast forth their young ones when they get rid of their pangs**
- Job 39:30. **And its young ones themselves keep sipping up blood and where the slain are there it is**
- Job 41:5. **Will you play with it as with a bird or will you tie it for your young girls**
- Psalms 17:12.. **His likeness is that of a lion that yearns to tear to pieces and that of a young lion sitting in concealed places**
- Psalms 22:12. **Many young bulls have surrounded me the powerful ones of Bashan themselves have got around me**
- Psalms 34:10. **The maned young lions themselves have had little on hand and gone hungry but as for those seeking Yehowah they will not lack anything good**
- Psalms 35:17. **O Yehowah how long will you keep seeing it Do bring back my soul from their ravages even my only one from the maned young lions**
- Psalms 37:25. **A young man I used to be I have also grown old and yet I have not seen anyone righteous left entirely nor his offspring looking for bread**

Ezekiel 19:3. **And gradually she brought up one of her cubs A maned young lion is what he became and he began to learn how to tear apart prey He devoured even earthling man**

Ezekiel 19:5. **When she got to see that she had waited and her hope had perished then she took another of her cubs As a maned young lion she put him forth**

Ezekiel 19:6. **And he began to walk about in the midst of lions A maned young lion is what he became And he gradually learned how to tear apart prey He devoured even earthling man**

Ezekiel 45:18. **This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said In the first month on the first day of the month you should take a young bull a son of the herd a sound one and you must purify the sanctuary from sin**

Ezekiel 45:22. **And on that day in his own behalf and in behalf of all the people of the land the chieftain must provide a young bull as a sin offering**

Ezekiel 45:23. **And for the seven days of the festival he should provide as a whole burnt offering to Yehowah seven young bulls and seven rams sound ones daily for the seven days and as a sin offering a buck of the goats daily**

Ezekiel 45:24. **And as a grain offering an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram he should provide and as regards oil a hin to the ephah**

Ezekiel 46:6. **And on the day of the new moon there should be a young bull the son of the herd a sound one and six male lambs and a ram sound ones they should prove to be**

Ezekiel 46:7. **And an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram he should render up as a grain offering and for the male lambs according to what he is able to afford and as regards oil a hin to the ephah**

- Ezekiel 46:11. **And in the festivals and in the festal seasons the grain offering should prove to be an ephah for the young bull and an ephah for the ram and for the male lambs as he is able to give and as regards oil a hin to the ephah**
- Hosea 4:16.. **For like a stubborn cow Israel has become stubborn Is it now that Yehowah will shepherd them like a young ram in a roomy place**
- Hosea 5:14. **For I shall be like a young lion to Ephraim and like a maned young lion to the house of Judah I I myself shall tear to pieces and I shall go and carry off and there will be no deliverer**
- Hosea 13:7. **And I shall become to them like a young lion Like a leopard by the way I shall keep looking**
- Hosea 14:2. **Take with yourselves words and come back to Yehowah Say to him all YOU people May you pardon error and accept what is good and we will offer in return the young bulls of our lips**
- Joel 2:28.. **And after that it must occur that I shall pour out my spirit on every sort of flesh and YOUR sons and YOUR daughters will certainly prophesy As for YOUR old men dreams they will dream As for YOUR young men visions they will see**
- Amos 2:11.. **And I kept raising up some of YOUR sons as prophets and some of YOUR young men as Nazirites Should this really not be O sons of Israel is the utterance of Yehowah**
- Amos 3:4. **Will a lion roar in the forest when it has no prey Will a young maned lion give forth its voice from its hiding place if it has caught nothing at all**
- Amos 4:10. **I sent among YOU people a pestilence in the nature of that of Egypt With the sword I killed YOUR young men along with the taking captive of YOUR horses And I kept making the stink of YOUR camps ascend even into YOUR nostrils but YOU did not come back to me' is the utterance of Yehowah**

- Amos 6:4. **YOU men that are lying down on couches of ivory and are sprawling on their divans and are eating the rams out of a flock and the young bulls from among fattened calves**
- Amos 8:13. **In that day the pretty virgins will swoon away also the young men because of the thirst**
- Micah 5:8.. **And the remaining ones of Jacob must become among the nations in the midst of many peoples like a lion among the beasts of a forest like a maned young lion among droves of sheep which when it actually passes through certainly both tramples down and tears in pieces and there is no deliverer**
- Nahum 2:11.. **Where is the lair of lions and the cave that belongs to the maned young lions where the lion walked and entered where the lion's cub was and no one was making them tremble**
- Nahum 2:13. **Look I am against you is the utterance of Yehowah of armies and I will burn up her war chariot in the smoke And a sword will devour your own maned young lions And I will cut off from the earth your prey and no more will the voice of your messengers be heard**
- Zechariah 2:4.. **Then he said to him Run speak to the young man over there saying As open rural country Jerusalem will be inhabited because of the multitude of men and domestic animals in the midst of her**
- Zechariah 9:17. **For O how great his goodness is and how great his handsomeness is Grain is what will make the young men thrive and new wine the virgins**
- Zechariah 11:3. **Listen The howling of shepherds for their majesty has been despoiled Listen The roaring of maned young lions for the proud thickets along the Jordan have been despoiled**
- Zechariah 11:16. **For here I am letting a shepherd rise up in the land To the sheep being effaced he will give no attention The young one he**

**will not seek and the broken sheep he will not heal The one stationing herself he will not supply with food and the flesh of the fat one he will eat and the hoofs of the sheep he will tear off**

**Matthew 2:8.. and when sending them to Bethlehem he said Go make a careful search for the young child and when YOU have found it report back to me that I too may go and do it obeisance**

**Matthew 2:9. When they had heard the king they went their way and look the star they had seen when they were in the east went ahead of them until it came to a stop above where the young child was**

**Matthew 2:11. And when they went into the house they saw the young child with Mary its mother and falling down they did obeisance to it They also opened their treasures and presented it with gifts gold and frankincense and myrrh**

**Matthew 2:13. After they had withdrawn look Yehowah's angel appeared in a dream to Joseph saying Get up take the young child and its mother and flee into Egypt and stay there until I give you word for Herod is about to search for the young child to destroy it**

**Matthew 2:14. So he got up and took along the young child and its mother by night and withdrew into Egypt**

**Matthew 2:20. and said Get up take the young child and its mother and be on your way into the land of Israel for those who were seeking the soul of the young child are dead**

**Matthew 2:21. So he got up and took the young child and its mother and entered into the land of Israel**

**Matthew 10:35. For I came to cause division with a man against his father and a daughter against her mother and a young wife against her mother-in-law**



- Matthew 11:16. **With whom shall I compare this generation It is like young children sitting in the marketplaces who cry out to their playmates**
- Matthew 14:21. **Yet those eating were about five thousand men besides women and young children**
- Matthew 15:38. **Yet those eating were four thousand men besides women and young children**
- Matthew 18:2. **So calling a young child to him he set it in their midst**
- Matthew 18:3. **and said Truly I say to YOU Unless YOU turn around and become as young children YOU will by no means enter into the kingdom of the heavens**
- Matthew 18:4. **Therefore whoever will humble himself like this young child is the one that is the greatest in the kingdom of the heavens**
- Matthew 18:5. **and whoever receives one such young child on the basis of my name receives me also**
- Matthew 19:13. **Then young children were brought to him for him to put his hands upon them and offer prayer but the disciples reprimanded them**
- Matthew 19:14. **Jesus however said Let the young children alone and stop hindering them from coming to me for the kingdom of the heavens belongs to suchlike ones**
- Matthew 19:20. **The young man said to him I have kept all these what yet am I lacking**
- Matthew 19:22. **When the young man heard this saying he went away grieved for he was holding many possessions**

- Matthew 24:32. **Now learn from the fig tree as an illustration this point Just as soon as its young branch grows tender and it puts forth leaves YOU know that summer is near**
- Mark 5:39.. **and after stepping in he said to them Why are YOU causing noisy confusion and weeping The young child has not died but is sleeping**
- Mark 5:40. **At this they began to laugh scornfully at him But having put them all out he took along the young child's father and mother and those with him and he went in where the young child was**
- Mark 5:41. **And taking the hand of the young child he said to her Talitha cumi which translated means Maiden I say to you Get up**
- Mark 7:30. **So she went away to her home and found the young child laid on the bed and the demon gone out**
- Mark 9:24. **Immediately crying out the father of the young child was saying I have faith Help me out where I need faith**
- Mark 9:36. **And he took a young child stood it in their midst and put his arms around it and said to them**
- Mark 9:37. **Whoever receives one of such young children on the basis of my name receives me and whoever receives me receives not me only but also him that sent me forth**
- Mark 10:13. **Now people began bringing him young children for him to touch these but the disciples reprimanded them**
- Mark 10:14. **At seeing this Jesus was indignant and said to them Let the young children come to me do not try to stop them for the kingdom of God belongs to suchlike ones**
- Mark 10:15. **Truly I say to YOU Whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a young child will by no means enter into it**

Mark 13:28, **Now from the fig tree learn the illustration Just as soon as its young branch grows tender and puts forth its leaves YOU know that summer is near**

Mark 14:51, **But a certain young man wearing a fine linen garment over his naked body began to follow him nearby and they tried to seize him**

Mark 16:5, **When they entered into the memorial tomb they saw a young man sitting on the right side clothed in a white robe and they were stunned**

Luke 1:59, **And on the eighth day they came to circumcise the young child and they were going to call it by the name of its father Zechariah**

Luke 1:66, **and all that heard made note of it in their hearts saying What really will this young child be For the hand of Yehowah was indeed with it**

Luke 1:76, **But as for you young child you will be called a prophet of the Most High for you will go in advance before Yehowah to make his ways ready**

Luke 1:80, **And the young child went on growing and getting strong in spirit and he continued in the deserts until the day of showing himself openly to Israel**

Luke 2:17, **When they saw it they made known the saying that had been spoken to them concerning this young child**

Luke 2:24, **and to offer sacrifice according to what is said in the law of Yehowah A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons**

Luke 2:27, **Under the power of the spirit he now came into the temple and as the parents brought the young child Jesus in to do for it according to the customary practice of the law**

- Luke 2:40, **And the young child continued growing and getting strong being filled with wisdom and God's favor continued upon him**
- Luke 7:14, **With that he approached and touched the bier and the bearers stood still and he said Young man I say to you Get up**
- Luke 7:32, **They are like young children sitting in a marketplace and crying out to one another and who say We played the flute for YOU but YOU did not dance we wailed but YOU did not weep**
- Luke 9:47, **Jesus knowing the reasoning of their hearts took a young child set it beside him**
- Luke 9:48, **and said to them Whoever receives this young child on the basis of my name receives me too and whoever receives me receives him also that sent me forth For he that conducts himself as a lesser one among all of YOU is the one that is great**
- Luke 11:7, **And that one from inside says in reply Quit making me trouble The door is already locked and my young children are with me in bed I cannot rise up and give you anything**
- Luke 15:23, **And bring the fattened young bull slaughter it and let us eat and enjoy ourselves**
- Luke 15:27, **He said to him Your brother has come and your father slaughtered the fattened young bull because he got him back in good health**
- Luke 15:30, **But as soon as this your son who ate up your means of living with harlots arrived you slaughtered the fattened young bull for him**
- Luke 18:16, **However Jesus called the infants to him saying Let the young children come to me and do not try to stop them For the kingdom of God belongs to suchlike ones**

Luke 18:17. Truly I say to YOU Whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a young child will by no means get into it

John 4:49.. The attendant of the king said to him Lord come down before my young child dies

John 12:14. But when Jesus had found a young ass he sat on it just as it is written

John 16:21. A woman when she is giving birth has grief because her hour has arrived but when she has brought forth the young child she remembers the tribulation no more because of the joy that a man has been born into the world

John 21:5. Then Jesus said to them Young children YOU do not have anything to eat do YOU They answered No to him

Acts of Apostles 2:17.. ` And in the last days God says I shall pour out some of my spirit upon every sort of flesh and YOUR sons and YOUR daughters will prophesy and YOUR young men will see visions and YOUR old men will dream dreams

Acts of Apostles 5:10. Instantly she fell down at his feet and expired When the young men came in they found her dead and they carried her out and buried her alongside her husband

Acts of Apostles 7:58. And after throwing him outside the city they began casting stones at him And the witnesses laid down their outer garments at the feet of a young man called Saul

Acts of Apostles 20:9. Seated at the window a certain young man named Eutychus fell into a deep sleep while Paul kept talking on and collapsing in sleep he fell down from the third story and was picked up dead

Acts of Apostles 23:17. So Paul called one of the army officers to him and said Lead this young man off to the military commander for he has something to report to him

Acts of Apostles 23:18. **Therefore this man took him and led him to the military commander and said The prisoner Paul called me to him and requested me to lead this young man to you as he has something to tell you**

Acts of Apostles 23:22. **Therefore the military commander let the young man go after ordering him Do not blab to anyone that you have made these things clear to me**

1 Corinthians 14:20.. **Brothers do not become young children in powers of understanding but be babes as to badness yet become full-grown in powers of understanding**

Titus 2:4.. **that they may recall the young women to their senses to love their husbands to love their children**

Hebrews 2:13.. **And again I will have my trust in him And again Look I and the young children whom Yehowah gave me**

Hebrews 2:14. **Therefore since the young children are sharers of blood and flesh he also similarly partook of the same things that through his death he might bring to nothing the one having the means to cause death that is the Devil**

Hebrews 9:12. **he entered no not with the blood of goats and of young bulls but with his own blood once for all time into the holy place and obtained an everlasting deliverance for us**

Hebrews 9:19. **For when every commandment according to the Law had been spoken by Moses to all the people he took the blood of the young bulls and of the goats with water and scarlet wool and hyssop and sprinkled the book itself and all the people**

Hebrews 11:23. **By faith Moses was hid for three months by his parents after his birth because they saw the young child was beautiful and they did not fear the order of the king**

**1 John 2:13..** I am writing YOU fathers because YOU have come to know him who is from the beginning I am writing YOU young men because YOU have conquered the wicked one I write YOU young children because YOU have come to know the Father

**1 John 2:14.** I write YOU fathers because YOU have come to know him who is from the beginning I write YOU young men because YOU are strong and the word of God remains in YOU and YOU have conquered the wicked one

**1 John 2:18.** Young children it is the last hour and just as YOU have heard that antichrist is coming even now there have come to be many antichrists from which fact we gain the knowledge that it is the last hour

**Revelation 4:7..** And the first living creature is like a lion and the second living creature is like a young bull and the third living creature has a face like a man's and the fourth living creature is like a flying eagle
